It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of TTC Technology Corp. (f/k/a SmarTire Systems Inc.) because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended April 30, 2009.

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of TWL Corp. because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended March 31, 2008. It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of TXP Corp. because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended September 30, 2008.
