# Airports Division, Great Lakes Region Federal Aviation Administration FY-2012 Performance Goals

### NEXT LEVEL OF SAFETY

- 1. Complete eight (8) Runway Safety Area improvements.
- 2. Ensure that all Part 139 Certificated Airports have initiated a Wildlife Hazard Assessment.
- 3. Conduct airport safety inspections per the regional FY-2012 work plan.
- Analyze and investigate vehicle/pedestrian deviations (V/PDs) to identify causes and preventive actions. Conduct at least two (2) V/PD workshops based on this analysis.
- 5. Implement Safety Management System for all large hub airports in the Great Lakes Region, with Safety Risk Assessments using the SAS-1 form on thirteen (13) AGL Large Hub projects identified in SOAR for FY 2012.
- 6. Conduct at least three (3) ARP-led Safety Risk Management Panels at Large Hub airports for FY 2012 projects.

#### **AVIATION ACCESS**

- Conduct at least two (2) land use inspections at general aviation airports and at least one compliance-related outreach activity.
- 8. Coordinate with the airport sponsor and approve 75% of airport single audit findings and proposed corrective actions within sixty (60) days of receiving the report.
- Provide twice a year updates of airport construction projects likely to affect capacity at the 77 Aviation System Performance Metrics (ASPM) Airports.

- 10. Conduct internal regional grant documentation reviews in all four Airports District Offices and report results by the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter.
- 11. Program 90% of the initial allocation of Discretionary funds within 60 calendar days of funds being made available.
- 12. Close 50% or five (5) of the ten (10) open Passenger Facility Charge applications that were both physically and financially complete as of October 1, 2010.
- 13. Develop a target and a metric to measure AIP Grant Oversight in FY-2012 and publish final AIP risk-based policy and supporting guidance.
- 14. Attend and provide a written internal summary report within fourteen (14) days of OIG meetings with FAA and/or Airport Sponsors.

## WORKPLACE OF CHOICE

- Directly link employee performance plans to FAA strategic goals and to the FY-2012 Airports Division Business Plan.
- 16. Establish a timeline for the implementation of standard operating procedures and brief aviation groups regarding the implementation of the SOPs and effects on standardization.

#### SUSTAIN OUR FUTURE

- 17. Work with Headquarters to identify and direct AIP funding for eligible VALE projects in the region.
- Provide interim reports twice a year on lessons learned from Sustainability Pilot Program Projects.
- 19. Work with Headquarters to identify and direct AIP funding for approved noise compatibility projects.
