TTB PUBLISHES TWO DOCUMENTS IMPLEMENTING CHANGES MADE TO THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE BY THE CHILDREN'S HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REAUTHORIZATION ACT OF 2009 (CHIPRA)

Washington, D.C. – The Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) published a Temporary Rule and a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) in today's Federal Register. The temporary rule (T.D. TTB-78) implements certain changes made to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 by the Children's Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2009. The principal changes involve permit and related requirements for manufacturers and importers of processed tobacco and an expansion of the definition of roll-your-own tobacco.

The NPRM (Notice #95) solicits comments from interested parties on the amendments found in the temporary rule.

Written comments on the NPRM must be received on or before August 21, 2009.
