Executive summary

Analysis and reporting of results for the National Emergency Preparedness and Response (NEPR) Initiative follow-up assessment was a focus this quarter, as was preparation for upcoming classes at the Medical Library Association annual meeting. Cindy facilitated a teleconference in February with the RML Associate Directors to gather their suggestions regarding the draft Online Contract Report form for outreach subcontractors. In April, the quarterly Evaluation Liaisons' Teleconference featured NN/LM NER's Javier Crespo, Michelle Eberle, and Sabrina Kurtz-Rossi presenting information about their Focused Outreach project and was attended by 22 people. Susan Barnes returned to full time work status at the beginning of March.

Dissemination of effective practices

Susan Barnes agreed to become co-chair of the Outreach Connections Promotion Subcommittee, sharing the responsibility with Loriene Roy of the University of Texas School of Information. She led a teleconference meeting of the subcommittee in April, in which the group discussed its next steps. Cindy Olney submitted a proposal to the American Evaluation Association for a panel presentation on a method she developed for validating qualitative data, featuring the OERC's evaluation of the Community Day pilot projects as an example of this method. (Judith Livingston, from the University of Texas Health Sciences Center at San Antonio Department of Pediatrics has agreed to be the second presenter on the panel.)

Subcontractor update

Not applicable. The OERC has no subcontracts at present.

Other staff activities—this section is organized according to OERC's goals for the 2006-2011 contract

I. Develop awareness, skill, and capacity in use of evaluation methods.

Training:

Susan co-taught "Measuring Your Impact" with NN/LM PSR's Alan Carr at the Joint meeting of the Medical Library Group of Southern California and Arizona and Northern California and Nevada Medical Library Group in February. In March, she developed and presented a one-hour webinar on "Questionnaire Design" for NN/LM PNR's RML Rendezvous. During the quarter, Cindy Olney and Susan spent extensive time working with Debra Cavanaugh of the Medical Library Association to test and become familiar with the MLA's MegaMeeting webinar software that will be used in May when the OERC presents its "Valuing Your Library" class to a group of participants at the annual meeting in Minneapolis and, simultaneously, to a group of remote participants. Cindy also worked to update this class, and the "Finding Information in Numbers and Words: Data Analysis for Program Evaluation" class, for the OERC's upcoming sessions at the MLA annual meeting in May.

II. Develop mechanisms to disseminate and use evaluation findings to help NLM and the NN/LM document and demonstrate their accomplishments <u>Publications</u>:

The OERC continued to provide full-text online access to the *Planning and Evaluating Health Information Outreach* booklets and the *Measuring the Difference* guide, and distributed 76 sets of the three *Planning and Evaluating Health Information Outreach* booklets.

III. Strengthen and build an evaluation culture throughout NN/LM.

Evaluation Liaisons:

On April 26, the quarterly Evaluation Liaisons' Teleconference featured NN/LM NER's Javier Crespo, Michelle Eberle, and Sabrina Kurtz-Rossi presenting information about their Focused Outreach project. The RMLs' Associate Directors, Outreach/Evaluation coordinators, and Consumer Health coordinators were invited, and 22 people attended.

Evaluation:

Cindy facilitated a teleconference in February with the RML Associate Directors to gather their suggestions regarding the draft Online Contract Report form for outreach subcontractors. In March, she travelled to St. Louis to consult with NN/LM MCR's Claire Hamasu and Betsy Kelly about regional program evaluation. In April the OERC provided feedback to Cindy Love of NLM's DIMRC about a questionnaire she was developing for NLM and MLA to assess medical librarian's attitudes and needs regarding a proposed MLA Disaster Information Specialist certification. Susan and Cindy also provided feedback to NN/LM SEA's PJ Grier and members of his group purchasing task force about a questionnaire for network member hospital libraries this quarter.

- VI. Provide consultation and direction in implementing evaluation systems, structures, and resources to help the NN/LM's efficacy and efficiency.

- V. Enhance and refine use of community-based approaches to evaluation.

Cross-regional collaboration

Cindy analyzed responses to the NEPR follow-up assessment, submitted a preliminary report to the National Network Office, the Associate Directors, and Dan Wilson (for his presentation in March at the NLM Symposium on Disaster Information Outreach). She travelled to Chicago in April to present these preliminary results at the Chicago Summit for the NEPR. Cindy and Susan worked with Dan Wilson on the NEPR Initiative presentation for the upcoming RML Directors' Meeting in May.
