




FRAIID CASES

AFOSI conducts both Central Systems Economic Crime (CSEC) and Base Level Economic Crime (BLEC) investigations.

- CSEC is the investigation of procurement economic crime involving weapon systems, subsystems and parts.
- BLEC is the investigation of economic crime involving military construction, base service contracts and commodities contracts.
- Over the last 5 years, our CSEC and BLEC investigations have resulted in a total of \$1.5 billion in recoveries.
- In CY 2010, CSEC investigations resulted in \$41 million in recoveries and BLEC investigations resulted in nearly \$1.7 million in recoveries.

DEPLOYMENTS

At any given time, there are around 200 AFOSI personnel deployed worldwide at more than a dozen locations. More than 950 combat support missions have been conducted in the past year in Iraq and Afghanistan.

CYBER OPERATIONS

AFOSI's Defense Computer Crime Center has become a national center of excellence for computer forensics and training. Our agency also employs agents, analysts and professional staff to conduct cyber investigations worldwide.

NUCLEAR ENTERPRISE

AFOSI provides nuclear convoy escort security, supporting Air Force Global Strike Command and the Air Force's priority to strengthen the Nuclear Enterprise.

TRAINING

AFOSI agents receive their initial 18-week training at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center. During this intense criminal investigators course, agents learn the foundations of conducting investigations and focus on civilian law, writing warrants, affidavits, and working with AUSAs. The follow-on course is AFOSI specific, administered by our Special Investigations Academy where agents learn how to investigate cases with regard to violations of the UCMJ.
