

### **How to Nominate**

We request nominations of exemplary Federal employees participating in the Federal motor vehicle fleet management program. The department/agency head or designee must sign all letters transmitting nominations. Each department or agency may nominate up to four individuals. The Secretary of Defense, representing also the Departments of the Air Force, Army and Navy, may submit up to 16 candidates for these awards. We also accept self-nominations; however, the department/agency head or designee must endorse all self-nomination transmittal letters. Group nominations will not be accepted; however, you are encouraged to nominate individuals who may have led the group(s).

The nominees will be evaluated by an independent panel of industry and government experts from the motor vehicle fleet management community. Judges will use the criteria established by the Federal Fleet Policy Council (FedFleet) Subcommittee to Revise the Awards' Criteria.

### **Contractors are excluded from participation or nomination.**

## **Eligibility**

Motor vehicle fleet personnel responsible, as their primary duty, for the performance for an agencyowned or leased fleet in excess of 20 vehicles for small fleets or 500 or more vehicles for large fleets; that have excelled in professional fleet management; demonstrated innovative methods towards meeting Federal fleet challenges; and achieved superior results in their responsible fleet performance.

## **Submission Requirements**

Each nomination must include the nomination form, a narrative describing the nominee's accomplishments, and a brief biography of the nominee. Visit our website at http://www.gsa.gov/vehiclepolicy to obtain the evaluation criteria and instructions.
