MSDE Security Patch Now Available for POS v5.4

The Microsoft SQL Server Desktop Engine (MSDE) 2000 Security Patch KB960083 for the Point of Sale (POS) component of PCC OTC is now available for downloading from the PCC OTC website. It is very important that all locations and computers using PCC OTC download this patch. A security issue was identified in MSDE 2000 that could allow an attacker to compromise the user's system. This patch will alleviate this security vulnerability. Agencies using the POS application are encouraged to install this patch by downloading it from our secure website. No POS data will be lost due to this installation.
