ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR IN CAMERA TREATMENT

I.

On January 19, 2005, the parties filed a joint stipulation ("Joint Stipulation"), through which the parties agreed to offer into evidence deposition designations identified in Appendix 1 to JX 6. The parties indicate that the deposition testimony is in lieu of live testimony and seek *in camera* treatment for specific portions of the proposed deposition testimony.

II.

The Order on Non-parties' Motions for *In Camera* Treatment, issued on October 7, 2004, sets forth the standard by which requests for *in camera* treatment are evaluated. The parties seek *in camera* treatment for narrowly tailored portions of deposition testimony from non-parties. The Joint Stipulation demonstrates that the portions of the deposition testimony for which *in camera* treatment is sought contain information that is related to material or testimony for which *in camera* treatment has previously been granted. The non-parties, from whom the deposition testimony was taken, have previously demonstrated, through affidavits or declarations, that the testimony for which *in camera* treatment is sought contains confidential information and that the disclosure of such information could cause real and serious damage to the competitive positions of the non-parties.

Accordingly, the request for *in camera* treatment is GRANTED. *In camera* treatment, for a period of five years, to expire November 1, 2009, is granted to the following portions of the following depositions:
