ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLIES TO POST TRIAL BRIEFS AND REPLIES TO PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT

On April 19, 2005, Complaint Counsel filed an unopposed motion to extend the deadline for filing concurrent reply briefs and replies to proposed findings of fact.

By Order dated February 3, 2005, the deadline for filing replies to post trial briefs and to proposed findings of fact was April 13, 2005. After the parties exchanged post trial briefs and proposed findings, by motion dated March 21, 2005, the parties filed a joint request for an extension of time for filing replies. By Order dated March 23, 2005, the joint motion was granted and the deadline for filing replies to post trial briefs and proposed findings of fact was extended to May 11, 2005.

Complaint Counsel now seeks an additional sixty days for the filing of reply briefs and replies to proposed findings. Complaint Counsel states that this additional time is needed for reasons relating to ChevronTexaco's recently announced proposed acquisition of Unocal. Respondent Unocal does not oppose this request.

Accordingly, Complaint Counsel's unopposed motion is GRANTED. The February 3, 2005 Order and March 23, 2005 Order are modified to reflect the following new deadline:
