Q Wher are your father and mother now？A They are dead now，
Q In whet yoar did your father die？A Last year．（When read baok witness adds：＂I have since heard that my father and mothore are dead）．
Q When did your mother die？A Few years ago．Not quite three years ago．
e．When did you first come back to the United Statos？A In KS 23.
Q At what port did you Jand？A Montreal．
Q Did you go by Vietoria and Vancouver？A Yes．
Q Do you remesaber what month and day you $r$ each ad Vancouver？
A I to not remenber when I reached Vancouver but it seens to we $F$ left Hongkong about the first part of June of K．8．23．
Q Tou lert the united states when you were a ehild and did not come beck again until you were grown up？A Yes．
－Do you ranember any other streets in San Franciseo besides Dupomat Street？A 1 rementer one or two．
Q What ara they？A Washington and Polk Stroet，
0 Any athers？A oregon Street．
Q Any others？A Gan not remember any more．
Q Does Washincton Street eross Dupont Street or run in the same divection A I do not remember．
－Have you ever been back to San Franoisco sinoe you 子aft there as a ohilit？A Yes．
Q When did yau go back to San Francisco？A I was back in San Fran－ cisce in ks 23，apter I wess tpied and dipoherged，
Q．How long did yqutstay in san Prapeisco at that timen A Until Inst yoar，after the fire， 7 caise to 领 Paso．
－Did zoy go direst to gen Francisco after you wera disahargen in Hew York？A Yes．
Q．Wher 关d you crash freth Canaia into the unsted Statess A At Halone．
Q That month ware you sprasted 最 Matgae A Chinese 7th ranth． （Vhpn read bach says＂I was dischaleged ith agnth， 24 th day．＂）

Q Whera mere you kent 橡he yoy wang undar grrest？A At the de－

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ofricery whetiver I sou-d wo permittad to eater the United States, but was incuiflect taat 1 couda not be admitted, so afterwards I sneaked in and was arrested and discharged on trial.

- When you or your friend opoke to the Imatgration atuthorities were you asked a thole lot of quastions? A No, they only said that they could not allow me to enter the onited States.
Q What ald you tell the afficers in order to prove to them you had a rieht to onter the United Statesh a I said that i was born in San Francisco and wished to come beck to the United States to live, and he said that he was not sure whether I was born in San Pranoisco or not.
q Did you offer to prove to the Immigration authorities that you were born in Sen Francisco? A No.
Q Why ald n't you offer to prove to the Imaigration authoritiss that you were born in Sen Prancise of A I did not know What oviaence or proot was necessary, because I was a smell boy at that time.
\& You were not a smaj3 boy when you applied at Malone, were you?
A Mo, 1 was over 20 years old then.
Q Were you kept in the Imaigration detention shed or in the jail before you were tried.
A Jail.
Q When you were tried what proet dia you offer? A I ald not offer onything. Instead they geve me this paper as ovidence that I was discharg od by the juage.
Q bid n't you have any witnesses to prove to the juage that you were born in San Francisco? A Yes, my Pather's friend was e witness at that time in my behtif.
Q What was your father's friend's nainf $A$ Why do you ask ue these questions when I have already been tried and discharged.
Q We are not sure that you are the same man that was tried and disonarged, and I ask these questions to find out.
A Yes, this is my peper, delivereí to me in parson by the juage, in the presence of the custams officer.
Q What kind of looking man was the fudge? A I can not describe the juage in any way at alj, and 1 could not $r$ ell even whether he wea an old men or a young men, but I can only remember indistinctly his naxe as being Badger, not knowige his initiajs.
Q Did Mr. Badger weer a beard on his face? A 1 do not remember that. He had a little moustache.
Q How much railroad fere did you have to pay from Malone to sam Frazicisco? A I da not know hov tqueh was the fare fron Melone, N. Y., to San Franciacio, but it paid $\$ 70$ Chinese money to ny Iriond to get my ticket from Malone to san Prencisco. Afterwards this friend told me that he had paid $\$ 30$ more and told me that if 1 did not have the money to pay him at the time I oould pay him when I returned to China. I do not know whether that was $\$ 30$ Chinese or \#aericen.
- Was this other money Chinese or gol d? A I do not know.

Q How Jong ware you on the road from Malone to San Prancisco?
A I do not remember now.
Q Was it one day? A I do not rementer at all.

- Whs it three hours? A. If you do not believe me take my papers and investigate.
Q Do you swaar that you heve told the whole truth and nothing but the truth, in the forecing testimony which you have eiven?
${ }^{4}$ Yes.
Q That friends can we write to to see thether you were born in San menes col A I to not know of any at present, because the one who testified in my behelf at the time of my return from China ia now dead, and some who know that I was born in San Prancisco have gone to China, and others have gone to places unknown to He.

Q When did you reech E1 Paso froth San Prancisco？A I have beon here about a year now 1 deme here right after the fire in Set Francisco．
Q Wherewere you working in San Franciaco at the time of the fire？
A I worked at Ying Kee，Elias Yee Wah，on Poik Street．I do not remember the number．
Q When HE you left San Franciseo did you come by land or water？ By train．
Q Mare did you get on the train？A At Daklend．
Q How many days after the fire was that？A Few days，but I do not remember how many days，I do not remember anything now．
Q How much railread fare from San Francisco here？A About $\$ 40$ ．
\＆How far from San Prancisco to Oakland？A Just a little way．
On you walk from San Francisco to Oakland？A I never walked myself．I went over on the cars．
Q Did you go from San Prancisco to Dakland on the train or street cars？A 1 do not remember．Don＇t ask me any more，because I can not remember now．
Q Do you know anybody that ever walked from San Franciseo to Oakland？
A No，do not ask me any more questions．Investigate my case by the papers．
Q Thite 育 your merriage name？oy Wah．
Q Thet is your surname？A Yee．
Q Was it the Chinese 7 th month and 24 th day that you were discharged？
A Yes：
Q How do you remember thet date？A I remember that because I was discharged after having been in trouble，just the same or in the same way I can $r$ emember that I have been questioned by you todey．
Q Are you sure that it was not the Amer iean 7th month？
A Chinese 7 th month．
Q Why did n＇t you get on the train right in San Prancisco？
A Because at the time San Brancisco was on fire there was much debris all over San Francisco and dead bodies in the streets，so $I$ went to Oaklend．
Q How did you go to Oakiend from San Franciseo？A I do not remember There is a body of water separating．
Q You do not remember whether you went by frain or by boat？A．No，
Q Is Polk Street in Chinatown？A I do ngt know whether it is in Chinetown or not，but Polk Street is only a small street or sort of alley．
Q If you have been living there can＇t you tell whether it is in Chinatown？A Yes，it is near Chintatow．
Q How close to Dupont Street？A Yes，not very far．
Q Does it cross Dupont Street？A I do not remember that．
Q Who are the principal Chinese merchants in Sen Prancisco？
A Hai Hing Lung is the name of the store．
Q What street is the tai Hing Iung on？A I do not remember．
Q Were you ever in thet store？A No，I only heard of it．
Q What Chinese atores have you ever been in in San Pranoiscoo
A I do not rementer what stores in San Francisco that i have been in because I had to work so hard in the laundry，washing and ironing a 13 the time．
Q How often do the street cars run on Dupont Street？A Do not ask me anything mote．There is no fun to be asked so much． You ean take the papers to favestigate．
Q What is your friend＇筬 nam thit helped you at waxdex Malone？
A He is not uy friend．He was py father＇s Iriend．I do not know his pame．I only oasi him uncle．
Q When did you fipet see this vnele？A i met him for the first time in Nalane，because my father wrote to him to meet me there．
Q Did this men testify to the judge that you weve born in San Fran－ cisco？A Yea．

a Hew did he knows A. Secanse be was a irtend of my fathor's.
Q Fas he the onju vitness that you had at talone?
$A$ Yes. He was the on2y one.
g Is n't there splacone now in San Francisec that we can write to to find out whether you were born there? A 1 can not tell now, because i would have to innd out whether that friend is still there.
Q What Chinese were in San Prancisce when you were there that know about your birthr A a an not remember. There were friends in San Frencisco who know I wes barn in San Praneiaco. The people in the lavidry where i worked know I we born there, but 1 do not know where they are now.
Q Whet were the nemes of those people you worked with in the jaundry?
F Yoe Ah Ton; Ah Sata, I do not know his surname. 7 only remenber these tre.
Q Is it on iron bridge or a wooden brigge across from San Franeisco to Dakiand? A Iron.
Q How do you know that it is iton? A I never orossed it but it heard of it.

Q Tha $t$ diflect to you speak? A See Yup aisjoet.
Q Do yob understand this interpreter? A Yes, sir.
Q Is this the pey or given you by Com ${ }^{4}$ r. Badger when you were discharged? A Yes, str. (Paper shown being the one with photograph of withess attrached offered by him as evidence of his right to be in the Unitied States, dated July 24, 1897.
