FLETC DIRECTIVE NO: 71-01

DIRECTIVE TITLE: Access Control

EFFECTIVE DATE: 2/25/2005 **SUNSET REVIEW DATE:** 2/25/2009

1. POLICY: The Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) will control access to all FLETC facilities for the protection and well-being of all persons while they are on the FLETC facilities and for the protection of all property thereon.

2. SCOPE: This directive covers the admission and control processes for all persons entering, transiting, or departing the FLETC, Glynco; the FLETC Office of Artesia Operations; the FLETC Office of Cheltenham Operations; and any other properties or facilities owned or leased by the FLETC. However, management transitions and start-up activities at the Charleston training facility preclude inclusion of many site-specific responsibilities and procedures for that facility at this time. The accompanying manual will be reviewed and revised concerning site-specific information for the Charleston facility at a more appropriate future date. Where appropriate, references to the Charleston facility have been included.
