INTRODUCTION

- 1. This supplement to the Department of the Army Decimal File System is published for use in operation of the permanent subjective files of The Adjutant General's Office.
- 2. Explanation of the terms "Legend" and "Project", and the symbols "c-o" and "x":
- a. "Legend" indicates the title of the subdivision used in alphabetically subdividing the classification numbers, as outlined in paragraphs 13 and 14, Department of the Army Decimal File System (Revised Edition). "Legends", (i.e. alphabetical subdivisions) are used to extend the decimal classification to enhance its adaptability in meeting expansion needs of all activities.
- b. "Project" indicates that the item is a special activity for which a complete file is provided. In this case any file number, together with the correct designation of the activity may be used. Each "Project" is a complete decimal file in itself.
- c. The symbol, "c-o" indicates an alphabetical subdivision of the file number, and is referred to as a "cut-off". The file number, and the legend as given in the supplement may be used.
- d. The symbol, "x", used in the index to the supplement, indicates that a cut-off is authorized. Refer to the supplement for complete information before using.
- 3. The following points are important if proper use is to be made of the material here presented:
- tained in the Department of the Army Decimal File System Manual before reference is made to the supplement. In making use of the supplement be sure that the legends used are authentic, i.e., exactly as listed. Never use a legend except to file a paper in a listed cut-off or project. Never use a cut-off unless provision has been made for that cut-off, either in the basic file manual, or in the supplement. If necessity arises for a new cut-off, consult your supervisor who will arrange for the new item to be placed in the supplement.
- b. The index found herein is designed as an aid only. Certain transpositions have been made in the legends used in order that the index may be complete. DO NOT USE THE LEGENDS FOUND IN THE INDEX. ALWAYS REFER TO THE SUPPLEMENT.

- a. A surname governs in filing. Note: Brown, Browne. A surname, with initials or given names, is completed, in sequence, before the next name. e.g. Brown, A. Brown, F. Brown, Z. Browne, etc., Browns.
- b. Initials take precedence over a name beginning with that letter. Names and initials precede Jr., Company, etc. (See: h and i)
- c. Where a firm name contains letters with no apparent meaning, file the firm name as written.
- d. Ignore aposthrophe s ('s); ampersand (&); the words "an", "and", "the", etc., in filing.
- e. Compound names are filed as simple names. Ignore the hyphen. Compound names are sometimes indexed as simple names. e.g. James Easby-Smith is filed: Easby-Smith, James are to indexed: Smith, James Easby, and the index sheet so filed.
- f. A final "s", an integral part of a name, is used. Note: Brown's, (aposthrophe s not used); Browns, (final s is used) (See: a and d)
- g. Prefixes, whether capitalized or not, as "de", "De", "van", "Van", etc., are filed as an integral part of the name.
- h. Jr., III, IV, etc., are treated as a last initial in filing proper names; following the true name or initial; but preceding Company, etc., when occurring in a personal firm name.
- i. Company, Corporation, Incorporated, are used in filing. The complete word being used as a final item. (See: c and h)
- j. A business firm, using a proper name with no initials or given name, files as written. (See: c) Note d with reference to aposthrophe s ('s).

The subdivisions of the 322 group contain provision for files for all army units, or tactical organizations. Unless otherwise stated, wherever a cut-off is provided, any numbered tactical unit of the army is filed as a project.

Projects have been provided for all numerically designated tactical units, and in many cases projects are provided for tactical organizations designated by names. e.g. U.S. Army Band.

Cut-offs are provided for designations of groups or types of army units or organizations.

(See Introduction for definition of "Cut-off", "c-o", "x", and "projects".)

Following are illustrations of how the cut-offs and projects are applied to the 322 group:

Any correspondence pertaining to field armies, in general, will be classified: "322 Field Armies".

On the other hand, if the numerical designation of a particular field army is known, any authorized file number, (classification) in either the manual or the supplement may be used, followed by a complete designation of the field army: e.g. 220.3 Third Field Army, 451 3rd Field Army, etc. The same method of using the cut-off or project is to be applied to all other listings under each type of organization or unit.

Use only authorized listings. Apply to Chief Clerks for any needed new listings.

OUTLINE OF THE PROJECTS FILE

A.G.O. CENTRAL RECORDS

The projects are set up in twelve (12) groups or sections, appearing in the files in the order here shown. The arrangement of the groups is somewhat arbitrary, but is found to be convenient in operating the files. These groups or sections are given numbers, in sequence, for convenience in referring from one to another. Each group or section is alphabetically subdivided as shown.

In the "Special Projects", numbered 1, will be found an alphabetical list, containing all the projects in this group, except "Airplanes" and "Airways", which two are outlined.

In groups 2 to 12, inclusive, headings are given, with only enough items under each heading to give a clear outline of the contents of the projects files. These projects do not contain the army units, which are filed under 322. For the army units reference should be made to 322 in the supplement.

In group 3, "Geographic", in addition to the outline of the geographic project files, there has been added, in one alphabetical sequence, all the headings in groups 1 and 2, and in groups 4 to 12, inclusive. These added items show in which group the item is found. Thus, Group 3, in this outline, will serve as an index to the entire projects file.

In this connection it is to be remembered that this is an outline. There are hundreds of items in the files which are not shown in the outline. However, a study of the outline will enable one to know where to look. In indexing or placing project names on records, the files should be first consulted in any doubtful cases.

In some cases the correct filing place was doubtful. The file will be found, placed according to the best judgment of the files personnel. In these doubtful cases "dummy" cards have been placed in other possible filing places, showing just where the file is located. Thus, anyone with filing experience can take this outline and locate anything in the project files.
