1. What size containers are offered?

Everything from shoe boxes to large storage crates can be found with all sizes of boxes and containers in between.

2. How can this Schedule help my agency to be green?

In support of GSA's commitment to green offerings, plastic pallets are available which offer a longer life span over traditional wood pallets. In addition, maintenance and repair of containers keeps new resources from being tied up in the production of new containers.

3. What types of packaging services are offered?

4. What is Unique Identification (UID)?

UID is used for a variety of applications including supply chain management, logistics, and anti-counterfeiting, to improve inventory management and reduce operating costs. UID is a mandatory Department of Defense (DoD) requirement for all acquisitions beginning January 1, 2004.

5. What is Radio Frequency Identification (RFID)?

Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) is a method of remotely storing and retrieving data using devices called RFID tags/transponders. RFID allows for individual items to have a unique identifier and can identify many items at once.
