# Energy

As of FY2007, PBS is reporting to DOE reduced energy usage in Btus/GSF of 8.1% from the new 2003 baseline established in the Energy Policy Act of 2005.

# Historic Buildings

PBS manages 420 historic buildings including 11 National Historic Landmarks, 52 contributing buildings to National Historic Landmark Districts, 7 buildings contributing to a National Historic Site and 1 National Monument. Historic buildings comprise 25% of the owned inventory by square footage.

## **Land Ports of Entry**

- Ports of Entry: 120 leased and owned under GSA control

## Property Disposals

PBS transferred or sold 380 surplus properties for the Federal Government for over \$177,000,000. GSA transferred or sold 23 assets for PBS. Of the 23 assets, 8 PBS properties were sold for over \$69,000,000. The other 15 were federal transfers and public benefit conveyances valued at \$59,000.000.

# Recycling

Recycled over 400,000 tons of paper, glass, aluminum, and other traditional recyclable materials. Additionally, over 24,113 tons of construction-related materials, and 68 tons of electronic waste were recycled. Cost Avoidance: \$46,489,739.
