






Trends in Manufacturing Real GDP, Trade & Employment

Index, 2000 = 100




Distribution of GDP Growth by Component, 1996 - 2006






Global Balance: Current Account Balance as a Share of GDP by Country, 2010






U.S. Trade Picture, 1960-2011






Surplus on Services Trade







Surplus on Services and its Components, 3rd quarter 2011






Largest Trading Partners with U.S.








Largest Trade Surplus and Trade Deficit Partners, 2010














Domestic Share of U.S. Multinational Companies Employment


High-Income-Country Share of U.S. Companies' Foreign Affiliates Employment






Outsourcing: Exports to U.S. or Sales to Local Markets?
