### III. DRAFT ADVISORY OPINION 2011-25

Atlas Air Worldwide Holdings, Inc. by Stephen P. Roberts, Esq.

Chair Hunter noted that Mr. Roberts, the requestor's counsel, and Mr. Russell Pommer, the requestor's Associate General Counsel, were present and available to answer Commissioners' questions.

Chair Hunter recognized Mr. Joshua Blume of the General Counsel's Office who presented the draft advisory opinion concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and Federal Election Commission Minutes of an Open Meeting January 19, 2012

Commission regulations to the status of certain management employees at Atlas Air Worldwide Holdings, Inc.'s two subsidiary corporations. These employees are inactive members of the union that represents pilots at the subsidiaries. By virtue of their managerial roles, however, their participatory rights in and obligations to the union are significantly restricted. The requestor asks if these employees qualify as executive or administrative personnel such that the requestor may solicit contributions from them to its separate segregated fund.

of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and

**Commission regulations to Western Representation PAC's reporting** 

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obligations for independent expenditures to be made by advertisements placed on Facebook during the 2012 Presidential primary elections. The requestor asks whether it may 1) exclude the cost of each advertisement from its aggregation of costs for independent expenditures made with respect to given elections; and 2) report the costs of its Facebook advertisements on its monthly reports without having to attribute these costs to individual states' Presidential primary elections.

Mr. Backer and General Counsel Anthony Herman participated in the discussion which followed.

Chair Hunter stated that, because the 60-day response deadline for this Advisory Opinion is February 13, 2012, the Commission will continue to work on a draft response.
