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

U.S. natural gas production continues to grow








Domestic natural gas production grows faster than consumption


U.S. dry gas trillion cubic feet per year






Shale gas offsets declines in other U.S. production sources

Domestic crude supply increases, focused on lower-48 onshore production in the short term



U.S. dependence on imported petroleum continues to decline


U.S. liquid fuel supply million barrels per day





Global liquids production increases 25% while market shares hold relatively stable


liquids production million barrels per day
