Dear Mr. Kull:

Section 646 of the Treasury-Postal Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2001 requires the Inspector General of each department or agency to submit to Congress a report that discloses any activity relating to the collection of data about individuals who access any Internet site of the department or agency. Collection devices may include persistent cookies and web bugs. Persistent cookies are small software files placed on computers that can track the movement of a person on an Internet site over a specified period of time. Web bugs are invisible graphics included on the web site or in an e-mail designed to monitor who visits the web site or reads the e-mail. The President's Council on Integrity and Efficiency has asked this office to summarize the reviews conducted by the Inspectors General.

In general the reviews focused on:

- reviewing the agencies' use of persistent cookies and web bugs to collect information on individuals based on their visits to a web site, and determining whether the Head of the Agency personally approved the use of the collection device,
- determining whether the agencies' web sites used or entered into third-party agreements to obtain personnel information using collection devices, and
- determining whether the agencies' major web entry points have privacy statements posted that adequately reflect what, if any, personal information is collected, why it is collected, and how that information is used.

We received reports from 51 Inspectors General. Based on the results of reviews presented in these reports, we concluded that compliance with applicable policies has been inadequate. The individual Inspector General reports make recommendations for corrective actions at the department or agency level. A summary of the results is included in the following table.
