

John Steven Bius

Steve Bius is a Special Agent with the Environmental Protection Agency Office of Inspector General, and is detailed to the Inspector General Criminal Investigator Academy as Program Manager. He is responsible for the development, implementation and management of multiple training programs delivered to the federal Inspector General community.

Mr. Bius was formerly the Chief of the Training Management Division at the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC), where he served since 2005 as the FLETC Program Manager for all basic training and agency advanced training programs at Glynco, Georgia. He previously served as the Chief of the FLETC's Training Methodologies Branch, and as the Program Specialist for the Criminal Investigator Training Program.

Mr. Bius' law enforcement career includes nearly 15 years as a Special Agent with the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS). Mr. Bius developed extensive experience working counterintelligence operations and criminal investigations, including criminal cases against U.S. Navy personnel. During his tenure with NCIS, he also served as a member of the NCIS Surveillance Team, NCIS Protective Service Detail Team, as a NCIS Physical Fitness Coordinator, and as a NCIS Firearms Instructor. Mr. Bius' duties with the NCIS involved extensive international travel, including assignments in Germany, South Africa, and numerous countries in South America and Central America.

Prior to Mr. Bius' law enforcement career, he served in the U.S. Air Force for approximately five years, where achieved the rank of Captain. Mr. Bius holds a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from Valdosta State University. Additionally, he holds a Master of Education (concentration in criminal justice) from Troy State University, where he is pursuing a second graduate degree in international relations. In April 2009, Mr. Bius completed the Leadership for a Democratic Society program at the Federal Executive Institute.
