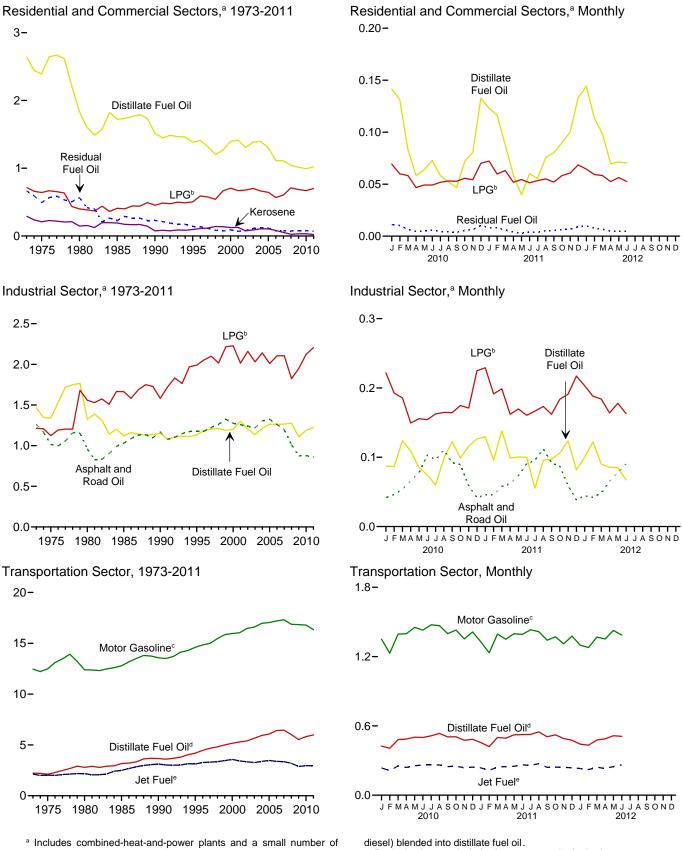
**Heat Content of Petroleum Consumption by Sector, Selected Products** Figure 3.8 (Quadrillion Btu)
