<b>Aberdeen</b>	Joan Azure reports no testing yet. Loaded Third Party Billing version 2.5 patch 4 at Fort Thompson but not yet at Fort Berthold. Possible Cache issues at Fort Berthold. Fort Thompson will test with ND Medicaid.
<b>Alaska</b>	Margi Buchwalter was unsure of status.
<b>Albuquerque</b>	Adrian is following up on testing with NM Medicaid.
<b>Bemidji</b>	Status Quo at Bemidji. Once patch 4 is loaded will begin working with MN Medicaid.

<b>Phoenix</b>	DeAlva Honahnie deferred to Charlotte Melcher who was not on the call.
<b>Tucson</b>	<i>No updated report provided.</i>
<b>ITSC Sandra Lahi</b>	837 Third party billing, p4 Arizona Medicaid (AHCCCs) certified patch 4 for filing with 837 claim formats AHCCCS is waiting on a deployment schedule for the 837 throughout Phoenix, Navajo and Tucson. AHCCCS is now using the 824 error

	<p>report to report errors in the 837 claim. Sites are having a hard time reading these error reports. A contract developer in Oklahoma has been able to pull the 824 report data into an Excel spreadsheet to improve reading the report . ITSC is working on obtaining this process. Charlotte Melcher also scheduled a training with AHCCCs with field Business Office Managers which includes reading error reports.</p> <p>Trailblazer’s error report is still using the 997 error report and ITSC is researching a process to assist the sites with responding to this type of error report.</p> <p>Ongoing 837 Testing with MS and NM Medicaid. More information on testing with Trailblazer will follow at the workshop.</p> <p><u>The 835 format is included in A/R v1.7 , p4, specific to the Medicare Part A 835 format.</u></p>
<p><b>Sandra Lahi</b></p>	<p>AR patch 4 released 1/15/04. For sites posting Part A, 835 format, patch 4 accommodates this format. Trailblazer will work with sites on testing.</p> <p>Working on patch 5. AHCCCS has a supplemental file that provides more detailed reporting of why claims are denied. Remittance Advice Remarks Codes will also be part of patch 5.</p> <p>ITSC is still working with PNC Bank on the Medicare Part B 835 and a pharmacy POS 835 file. Received a file from PNC Bank and this is being initially tested at Parker SU, Red Lake SU and Warm Springs.</p> <p><u>270/271 – Eligibility Inquiry &amp; Response</u></p>
<p><b>Sandra Lahi</b></p>	<p>Sill looking for test partners and sites to test. Let Sandra or Adrian know if you want to test. ITSC will work with sites when ready to test.</p>
	<p>Roland Todacheenie said Fort Defiance may be interested in becoming a test site. Carl Gervais stated this may be a problem because Navajo Area is working with QUOVADX .</p> <p><u>Item #3 – Business Transactions “Train the Trainer” Workshop:</u></p>
