**SUMMARY:** Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission has determined not to review the presiding administrative law judge's ("ALJ") initial determination ("ID") (Order No. 21) terminating the above-captioned investigation as to respondent Orion Electric Co., Ltd. of Fukui, Japan ("Orion Japan") on the basis of a settlement agreement.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Commission instituted this investigation on January 11, 2012, based on a complaint filed by Walker Digital LLC of Stamford, Connecticut ("Walker"), alleging a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1337), in the importation, sale for importation, and sale within the United States after importation of certain Blu-ray disc players, components thereof, and products containing the same, by reason of the infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent No. 6,263,505. 77 Fed. Reg.

1725 (Jan. 11, 2012). The notice of institution named thirty-five respondents, including Orion Japan. The Office of Unfair Import Investigations was also named as a party.

On May 17, 2012, Walker and Orion Japan jointly moved to terminate the investigation as to Orion Japan by reason of a settlement agreement between the parties. On May 29, 2012, the Commission investigative attorney filed a response in support of the motion. No other responses were filed.

On June 27, 2012, the ALJ issued the subject ID, granting the joint motion pursuant to section 210.21(b)(1) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 C.F.R. § 210.21(b)(1)). No petitions for review of the ID were filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the ID.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1337), and in section 210.42 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 C.F.R. § 210.42).
