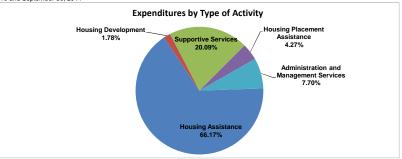

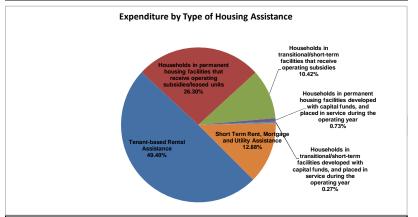

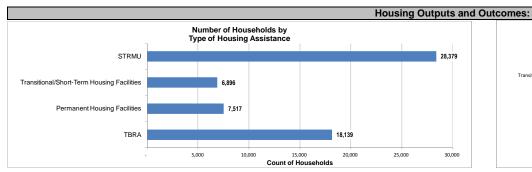

Expenditures by type of Activity: Housing Assistance is 66.17%; Housing Develoment is 1.78%; Supportive Services are 20.09%; Housing Placement is 4.27%; and Administration and Management Services are 7.70%.



Expenditures by type of Housing Assistance: Tenant-based Rental Assistance 49.40%; Households in permanent housing facilities that receive operating subsidies/leased units 26.30%; Households in transitional/short-term facilities that receive operating subsidies 10.42%; Households in permanent housing facilities developed with capital funds, and placed in service during the operating year 0.73%; Households in transitional/short term housing facilities developed with capital funds, and placed in service during the operating year 0.27%; Short Term Rent, Mortgage and Utility Assistance 12.88%.

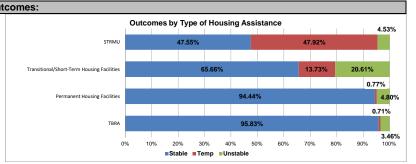
