## ORDER OF DISMISSAL (M.F. Global)

The Trustee of MF Global, Incorporated has submitted a copy of the order dated October 31, 2011, of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, granting the Security Investor Protection Corporations' petition to place MF Global in bankruptcy. Under 11 U.S.C. § 362(a), the filing of SIPC's petition operates as an automatic stay of this reparations proceeding. Accordingly, pursuant to CFTC rules 12.24(a)(2) and 12.24(d)(2), the proceeding as to MF Global d/b/a Fox Investments is dismissed without prejudice.

This reparations proceeding remains pending as to respondents Jay De Bradley, Farr Investments, Glenn Moore and Malik Sievers.

MF Global will be removed from the case name and the service list, and complainant and the remaining respondents are no longer required to serve copies of submissions on MF Global.
