

Housing Portal Internet User Guide

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1 Introduction to Housing Portal

1.1 Overview

Housing Portal is a web-based application that consolidates rental resources for evacuees identified by federal agencies, private organizations, and individuals.

1.2 Fair Housing

Housing listings provided through FEMA's Housing portal, should comply with all laws and executive orders governing fair access to housing.

1.3 Accessing Housing Portal

2 <u>Using Housing Portal</u>

2.1 Housing Portal Overview

All Users can access Housing Portal from the internet:

- Go to www.fema.gov.
- Click the Recover and Rebuild header.












• Click the "Find a Place to Stay" link on the left hand navigation bar.



• Click "Search for information about housing rental resources."







The Housing Portal homepage allows users to search for available housing with different search criteria.








2.2 Search Available Housing

Housing Portal allows users to search for available housing by multiple criteria including State, County, City, Zip, Bedrooms (Min/Exact), and/or Cost. You are at least required to select a State in order to run a search. **Note:** Once you select a state, only counties with available housing in the Housing Portal database will appear in the County dropdown list.

Once you have selected your desired search criteria, click the Search button.



Housing Portal will display available housing resources that match your search criteria. If you would like to collapse any result (view only the address) click the □ icon next to the property. To show the details click the □ icon next to the property.









2.3 Mapping Results

Housing Portal allows you to map up to 10 properties at a time using Google Maps.

From the search results page, click the Map button next to the properties that you wish to map.
 This will add the property to a mapping queue.



- Click the Map Now! button to map all of the properties in the queue.
- To display more information on a single property, click the address of the Housing Unit on the right hand side of the screen.
- Click Printer-friendly View to print the map.
- Click Return to Search Results to go back to the search results page.









2.4 Printing Search Results

Before you print, you may hide properties you are not interested in by using the \square icon next to the property. Print your search results by selecting **File** then **Print** on your browser.



2.5 New Search and Modify Search

To run a new search click the **New Search** button at the bottom of the search page or click the **Search Available Housing** link on the sidebar. To modify your search, simply click the **Modify Search** button.








2.6 Frequently Asked Questions
