HERE ARE A FEW OF OUR KEY STATISTICS THROUGH MARCH OF THIS FISCAL YEAR '08 WHICH REPRESENTS THE FIRST HALF OF THE FISCAL YEAR.

MISSIONS IN FISCAL YEAR '08 ARE 404, 778 WHICH IS A 23% GROWTH OVER FISCAL YEAR '07.

AUTHORIZED ORGANIZATION REPRESENTATIVES OTHERWISE KNOWN AS AOR'S REPRESENT A 57% GROWTH UP TO 111,085.

AORS ARE THOSE INDIVIDUALS ABLE TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS.

WITH THIS GROWTH, THE CONTACT CENTER VOLUME REMAINS CONSISTENT OVER FISCAL YEAR '07 AT 1%.

THIS EXHIBITS THAT CUSTOMERS ARE BECOMING MORE FAMILIAR WITH THE FIND AND APPLY PROCESS.

DURING OUR JANUARY 16TH WEBCAST, THE LATEST COMPATIBLE VERSION OF ADOBE READER WAS 8.1.1.



AFTER THAT WEBCAST, ADOBE RELEASED ADOBE READER VERSION 8.1.2. ON FEBRUARY 15TH, 2008, ADOBE READER 8.1.2 WAS VERIFIED AS TESTED AND COMPATIBLE WITH GRANTS.GOV.

WE ANTICIPATE THE RELEASE OF ADOBE READER 8.1.2 IN JUNE.

AND WE WILL TEST THE FUTURE ADOBE READER FOR COMPATIBILITY.

PLEASE CHECK FOR UPDATES ON THE "WHAT'S NEW" SECTION OF THE GRANTS.GOV HOME PAGE.

ON THE JANUARY 16TH WEBCAST, WE IDENTIFIED AN ISSUE THAT HAD JUST ARISEN REGARDING VERSION COMPATIBILITY.

IF AN APPLICANT DOWN LOADED AND SAVED AN ADOBE APPLICATION USING READER 8.1.1, AND ANOTHER USER IN THE ORGANIZATION WORKED ON THAT SAME APPLICATION USING AN INCOMPATIBLE VERSION SUCH AS 8.0, THEN THAT APPLICATION PACKAGE WAS CORRUPTED WITHOUT THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE APPLICANT.

THE CORRUPTION WAS IDENTIFIED ONCE THE PACKAGE WAS RECEIVED IN THE GRANTS.GOV DATABASE.

TO PREVENT THIS PROBLEM MOVING FORWARD, WE HAVE PLACED A TEST APPLICATION PACKAGE, WHICH YOU CAN ACCESS FROM OUR HOME PAGE UNDER "WHAT'S NEW THIS WEEK".

ONCE YOU CLICK ON THE "TEST APPLICATION PACKAGE", A SCRIPT WILL BE RUN ON YOUR COMPUTER TO VERIFY THAT YOU ARE USING A COMPATIBLE VERSION OF ADOBE READER. WHICH IS VERSION 8.1.1 OR 8.1.2.

IF YOU HAVE AN INCOMPATIBLE VERSION OF ADOBE READER ON YOUR COMPUTER, THIS DIALOGUE BOX WILL APPEAR.

IF THIS OCCURS, YOU NEED TO GO TO OUR DOWN LOAD SOFTWARE PAGE AND DOWN LOAD THE LATEST COMPATIBLE VERSION OF ADOBE READER 8.1.2.

YOU THEN MUST DOWN LOAD THE APPLICATION PACKAGE AGAIN.

AT THIS TIME, YOU CAN PROCEED WITH FILLING OUT THE APPLICATION PACKAGE.

JUST A REMINDER: YOU CAN E_MAIL QUESTIONS DURING THE BROAD CAST.

FROM THE VERSION OF THE ADOBE READER TO USE IS A COMMON QUESTION.

ADOBE ACK RA BOT PROFESSIONAL VERSION 8.1.2 IS ALSO COMPATIBLE FOR USE WITH GRANTS.GOV

ACROBAT.

FOR DETAILED INFORMATION ON ADOBE COMPATIBILITY WITH GRANTS.GOV PLEASE VISIT THIS LINK WHICH TAKES YOU TO A DEDICATED SECTION ON OUR FAQS AROUND ADOBE.

WE DO NOT RECOMMEND THE USE OF EARLIER SOFTWARE VERSIONS.

WE ARE ASKED: WHY IS GRANTS.GOV TRANSITIONING FROM PURE EDGE TO ADOBE? ADOBE FORMS PROVIDE INCREASED COMPATIBILITY WITH A WIDE RANGE OF OPERATING SYSTEMS SUCH AS WINDOWS, LINUX, UNIX, AND MACINTOSH.

VISTA AND OFFICE 2007 ARE ALSO COMPATIBLE WITH ADOBE WHERE AS THEY'RE NOT COMPATIBLE WITH PURE EDGE.

THE ADOBE SYSTEM WAS DESIGNED WITH THE LOOK AND FEEL OF THE PURE EDGE FORMS TO MINIMIZE THE IMPACT ON THE APPLICANT COMMUNITY.

IN A FEW MOMENTS, WE WILL DISCUSS THE AGENCY TRANSITION SCHEDULE TO ADOBE. BUT UNTIL THE TRANSITION IS COMPLETELY, OPPORTUNITIES ARE POSTED IN PURE EDGE AND ADOBE.

THEREFORE, WE RECOMMEND YOU HAVE BOTH THE PURE EDGE SOFTWARE AND THE LATEST COMPATIBLE VERSION OF ADOBE READER 8.1.2 INSTALLED ON YOUR COMPUTER. BOTH ARE ACCESSIBLE FOR FREE FROM THE GRANTS.GOV "DOWN LOAD SOFTWARE" PAGE.

ONCE YOU DOWN LOAD AN APPLICATION PACKAGE, THERE SEVERAL WAYS TO DISTINGUISH IF THE PACKAGE IS IN ADOBE OR PURE EDGE.

ONE WAY IS THE FILE EXTENSION.

FOR PURE EDGE, THE EXTENSION IS.XFD.

FOR ADOBE IT'S.PDF.

ANOTHER WAY TO IDENTIFY IS BY THE MANDATORY FIELD.

MANDATORY FIELDS IN PURE EDGE ARE IN YELLOW, MANDATORY FIELDS IN ADOBE ARE YELLOW WITH A RED RECTANGLE AROUND IT.

FOR OUR MACINTOSH COMMUNITY, ADOBE IS COMPATIBLE WITH MACOPERATING SYSTEMS, MAC OSX VERSION 10.4.3 OR HIGHER; TIGER AND LEOPARD ARE COMPATIBLE WITH PURE EDGE THERE IS LIMITED COMPATIBILITY THROUGH THE USE OF BOOTCAMP FOR LEOPARD OR YOU CAN UTILIZE OUR CITRIX SERVER CONNECTION OR IBM WORKPLACE FORMS WHICH IS THE MAC VERSION OF PURE EDGE. WE ARE OFTEN ASKED ABOUT THE WEB BROWSERS GRANTS.GOV SUPPORTS FOR ADOBE. THEY ARE THE MOST CURRENT VERSIONS OF INTERNET EXPLORER, FIRE FOX, NETSCAPE AND SAFARI. THIS WEEK WE HAVE THE TOP FIVE INQUIRIES INTO OUR CONTACT CENTER UPDATED ON OUR WHAT'S NEW THIS WEEK SECTION OF OUR HOME PAGE.

18% OF OUR CONTACTS IN THE MONTH OF MARCH WERE FOR PEOPLE LOOKING FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.

THE CONTACT CENTER IS MANNED BY CUSTOMER CARE OPERATORS OTHERWISE KNOWN AS C COs.

ONCE OUR CCOs CLEARLY IDENTIFY THE CALLER IS LOOKING FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, WE EXPLAIN TO THEM GRANTS.GOV IS FOR FEDERAL GRANTS AND WE DIRECT THEM TO GOV BENEFITS.GOV FOR ADDITIONAL HELP.

7% OF THE CONTACTS WERE FOR APPLICANTS INQUIRING AS TO THE STATUS OF THEIR APPLICATION.

WHEN YOU SUBMIT AN APPLICATION YOU WILL RECEIVE AN E_MAIL CONFIRMING THAT GRANTS.GOV HAS RECEIVED YOUR APPLICATION.

IN THE E_MAIL YOU WILL RECEIVE A GRANTS.GOV TRACKING NUMBER.



WITHIN 24_48 HOURS, YOU WILL THEN RECEIVE A VALIDATION E_MAIL WHICH MEANS YOUR APPLICATION HAS BEEN SUCCESSFULLY VALIDATED BY GRANTS.GOV.

TO THEN TRACK THE STATUS, YOU GO TO THE LEFT_HAND SIDE NAVIGATION BAR AND LOG IN TO TRACK YOUR APPLICATION.

6% OF THE CONTACTS PERTAIN TO SPECIFIC QUESTIONS ABOUT THE GRANT OPPORTUNITY.

THOSE CALLS ARE DIRECTED TO THE AGENCY POINT OF CONTACT ON THE OPPORTUNITY.

SO PLEASE KEEP IN MIND WHEN APPLYING FOR A GRANT, SPECIFIC QUESTIONS ABOUT AN OPPORTUNITY GO TO THE AGENCY AND NOT GRANTS.GOV.

6% OF CONTACTS ARE ABOUT FINDING OPPORTUNITIES.

SO, WHAT HAPPENS HERE IS OUR C COs ASSIST PEOPLE BY WALKING THEM THROUGH THE FIND PROCESS TO INCLUDE THE ADVANCED SEARCH FUNCTION.

5% OF THE CALLS ARE PEOPLE TO LOOKING TO START A SMALL BUSINESS.

THEREFORE, WE DIRECT THEM TO THE SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION.

SINCE OUR LAST WEBCAST, WE HAVE UPDATED THE AGENCY TRANSITION DATE TO ADOBE.

IN COORDINATION WITH THE AGENCY.

UPON SUCCESSFUL TESTING OF ADOBE, AGENCIES WILL BEGIN POSTING OPPORTUNITIES IN THE ADOBE SYSTEM.

ONE OF OUR TARGET DATES IS FOR AGENCIES TO BE IN ADOBE BY THE END OF THIS FISCAL YEAR WHICH IS SEPTEMBER 30, 2008.

FOR THOSE AGENCIES UNABLE TO TRANSITION BY THE END OF THIS FISCAL YEAR, GRANTS.GOV WILL CONTINUE TO PROCESS PURE EDGE SUBMISSIONS THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2008.

THE PURE EDGE SYSTEM IS SCHEDULED TO BE RETIRED JUNE 30, 2009.

THIS KEEPS WITH THE POLICY IN PLACE FOR GRANTS.GOV TO MAINTAIN A SIX MONTH ARCHIVE OF APPLICATIONS IN THE DATABASE.

13 AGENCIES ARE IN ADOBE TODAY.

TO DATE, 10,000 OF THE 104,000 SUBMISSIONS HAVE BEEN THROUGH ADOBE.

8 AGENCIES ARE SCHEDULED TO BE IN ADOBE BY SEPTEMBER 30. 2008.

WE ARE WORKING WITH THE REMAINING 5 ORGANIZATIONS AGENCIES ON THEIR TRANSITION TO ADOBE BY DECEMBER 2008.

ONE OF THE IMPACTS OF THE DECEMBER TRANSITION DATE ARE THE CHANGES BEING MADE WITH THE GOVERNMENT_WIDE RESEARCH AND RELATED FORMS WHICH ARE BEING UPDATED DUE TO THE TRANSPARENCY ACT AND A RENEWAL DUE TO THE EXPIRATION OF THESE FORMS.

THESE CHANGES TAKE TIME DO TO A PROCESS, THEREFORE, MANY OF THE RESEARCH AND RELATED AGENCIES ARE WAITING TO TRANSITION TO ADOBE AFTER ALL OF THESE CHANGES TO THE FORMS, ADOBE FORMS, HAVE BEEN TESTED AND IMPLEMENTED. SO RIGHT NOW WE WOULD LIKE TO TURN THE DISCUSSION OVER TO DENNA WHO WOULD LIKE TO TALK ABOUT SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS THAT OCCURRED ON APRIL 12TH, LAST WEEKEND.

>> : WELL, THANK YOU, MICHAEL.

WE HAVE BEEN VERY BUSY ADDING FEATURES AND ENHANCEMENTS.

IN FACT, WE HAVE PUT A NEW BUILD THIS WEEKEND, BUILD 2008-1 AS REFERRED TO BY OUR TEAM WAS DEPLOYED ON APRIL 12TH. 2008.

DURING THE DEPLOYMENT OF THIS BUILD, THE FIND AND APPLY FUNCTIONALITY REMAIN ACTIVE.

THIS BUILD INCLUDED 20 DIFFERENT SYSTEM REQUESTS THAT WE CALL SCRs. THEY'RE PART OF THE PROCESS WE USE TO UTILIZE THE FUNCTIONALTY OF OUR SYSTEM.

PRIOR TO THE BUILD WE DISTRIBUTED A DETAILED ENHANCEMENT VIA THE GRANTS.GOV UPDATE LIST SERVE WHICH YOU CAN SIGN UP BY GOING TO THE QUICK LINKS ON THE RIGHT_HAND SIDE OF THE GRANTS.GOV HOME PAGE.

THIS COMMUNICATION CAN ALSO BE ACCESSED VIA THE "WHAT'S NEW THIS WEEK" SECTION OF OUR HOME PAGE.

LET'S START OUT BY TAKING A LOOK AT A FEW OF THE HIGHER PRIORITY FIXES THAT USERS CAN SEE TODAY.

THIS SLIDE SHOWS PRIOR TO THE SYSTEM BUILD, THE SAVE AND SUBMIT BUTTON ON APPLICATION PACKAGES WAS BECOMING DISABLED AFTER A PACKAGE WAS REOPENED AS SHOWN IN FIGURE ONE.

AN APPLICATION PACKAGE THAT HAS BEEN COMPLETED, CHECKED FOR ERRORS AND SAVED WILL DISPLAY AN ACTIVE SAVE AND SUBMIT BUTTON AS SHOWN IN FIGURE TWO. NOW, REOPENING A SAVED APPLICATION PACKAGE WILL NOT DEACTIVATE THE SAVE AND SUBMIT BUTTON.

THE BUTTON WILL REMAIN ACTIVE UNLESS A PACKAGE HAS BEEN MODIFIED.

THIS ENHANCEMENT CALLED FOR A CHANGE IN THE TEXT OF THE SUBMISSION E_MAIL. THE TEXT IN THE E_MAIL WAS CHANGED TO PROVIDE A MORE PRECISE MESSAGE TO THE APPLICANT ABOUT THE STEPS OF THE PROCESS.

WE'RE TOLD THAT AN APPLICATION WAS READY FOR AN AGENCY TO RETRIEVE IT. THE E_MAIL NOW TELLS THEN THAT THE APPLICATION IS ACTUALLY RETRIEVED BY THE AGENCY.

THIS CHANGE BRINGS THE APPLICANT AN ENHANCED ABILITY TO TRACK THEIR APPLICATION.

NOW ALL OF THE INFORMATION REGARDING THE PACKAGE IS INCLUDED IN ONE PLACE, INFORMATION ABOUT THE SUBMITTER WAS MISSING AND NOW THE SUBMITTER'S NAME AND THE NUMBER HAS BEEN ADDED TO THE CONFIRMATION PAGE THAT DISPLAYS IMMEDIATELY AFTER AN APPLICATION HAS BEEN SUBMITTED.

THIS CHANGE WILL AID THE APPLICANT AND THEIR ASSOCIATES TO TRACK THE STATUS OF A PARTICULAR PACKAGE.

THIS CHART SHOWS THAT THE GRANTS.GOV TRACKING NUMBER HAS BEEN RELOCATED TO THE BEGINNING OF THE SUBJECT LINE AS SHOWN IN FIGURE 2.

THE TRACKING NUMBER IS STRATEGICALLY PLACED FIRST IN THE SUBJECT LINE TO HELP THE APPLICANT EASILY SEARCH AND ORGANIZE MULTIPLE SUBMISSION E_MAILS.

THE OLD SUBMISSION E_MAILS SUBJECT LINE DISPLAYED THE GRANTS.GOV TRACKING NUMBER AT THE END OF THE SUBJECT LINE.

THIS SLIDE SHOWS THE E_MAIL AND ERROR MESSAGE AN APPLICANT WILL RECEIVE IF THEY SUBMIT A PACKAGE FOR AN OPPORTUNITY THAT HAS BEEN DELETED BY THE GRANT OR AGENCY.

FIGURE 1 SHOWS THE AUTOMATED E_MAIL MESSAGE THE APPLICANT WILL RECEIVE VIA E MAIL.

AND FIGURE 2 SHOWS THE ERROR MESSAGE THAT WILL DISPLAY WHEN THE APPLICANT TRIES TO CHECK THE STATUS OF THEIR SUBMISSION.

PRIOR TO THE SYSTEM BUILD, ALL GRANTS.GOV USER ID NAMES WERE CASE NEUTRAL EXCEPT WHEN SUBMITTING AN ADOBE READER PACKAGE.

FOR SOME REASON THE PACKAGE MADE THE ID SENSITIVE.

THE APPLICANT HAD TO REMEMBER THE LETTER CASE COMBINATION THEY USED WHILE SUBMITTING EACH PACKAGE.

FIGURE 1 SHOWS THE RESULT OF ENTERING THE WRONG CASE SETTING FOR A CASE SENSITIVE USER ID.

AS YOU CAN SEE, THE SYSTEM WAS UNABLE TO LOCATE ALL OF THE PACKAGES. FIGURE 2 SHOWS ALL OF THE SUBMISSIONS LISTED FOR THE SAME USER ID WHICH IS NOW CASE NEUTRAL SO IT'S EASIER FOR THE APPLICANT TO KEEP TRACK OF ALL OF THE PACKAGES USING THEIR USER ID LOG_IN INFORMATION.

ONE OF THE THINGS WE'RE TALKING ABOUT AND SHOWING SCREEN SHOTS OF THE IMPACT ON THE APPLICANTS WHO HAVE DONE NUMEROUS THINGS ON THE GRANTOR SIDE.

CAN YOU EXPLAIN THE ONE ENHANCEMENT AROUND E_MAIL NOTIFICATIONS THAT BENEFIT THE APPLICANT?

>> : WELL, ACTUALLY, THIS IS REALLY VERY IMPORTANT.

WHEN AN APPLICANT RECEIVING THAT E_MAIL, IT NOW INCLUDES ALL OF THE INFORMATION THAT THEY NEED TO HAVE IN ORDER TO SUCCESSFULLY TRACK AND KNOW WHETHER OR NOT THEIR APPLICATION IS READY FOR SUBMISSION TO AN AGENCY.

>> : SO THAT'S ACTUALLY \square IT'S A REALLY GOOD THING BECAUSE BEFORE SOMETIMES IF AN AGENCY MAY HAVE JUST UPDATED A TEXT SPELLING CHANGE OR SOMETHING LIKE THAT, WE WEREN'T NOTIFYING PEOPLE OR WHAT HAVE YOU WITH CLEAR DEFINITIONS OR WE WERE SUPPRESSING THE E_MAILS.

>> : THAT'S RIGHT.

I WANTED TO MAKE SURE THAT WE WERE NOTING ON $\ \square\ \square$ I THINK THE VIEWERS CAN SEE THE SLIDE.

IT'S AN IMPORTANT FEATURE FOR OUR COMMUNICATIONS WITH APPLICANTS TO BE VERY COMPLETE.

AND I BELIEVE THAT WE HAVE GONE PRETTY FAR IN MEETING THAT REQUIREMENT.

>> : ONE OF THE OTHER THINGS IS WE'RE TALKING ABOUT THE BILL THAT WE JUST DID. WE DID 20SCRs, SYSTEM CHANGE REQUESTS.

THE UPCOMING BILL SCHEDULED FOR TENTATIVELY IN JULY, HOW MANY ARE WE LOOKING FOR THAT BUILD?

>> : THE NEW ONE HAS 40SCRs EARMARKED.

HOWEVER THOSE ARE THE ONES THAT WE'RE $\Box\Box$ MULLING OVER TO DECIDE HOW MANY WE CAN INCLUDE AND STILL MEET THE BUILD DEADLINE DATE OF JULY, MAYBE EARLY AUGUST TIME FRAME.

>> : WE HAD HAVE A CUSTOMER ENHANCEMENT FORM ON OUR WEB SITE BUT WE WORK WITH THE AGENCIES ON ENHANCEMENT AS WELL TO GET THEM INCLUDED INTO OUR SYSTEM CHANGE REQUESTS.

>> : IF I CAN JUST ADD A LITTLE BIT MORE, THE CHANGE NOTIFICATION E_MAIL THAT APPLICANTS RECEIVE WHEN A GRANT OPPORTUNITY HAS BEEN CHANGED, THIS IS THE SLIDE THAT I WAS TALKING TO YOU.

BEFORE THE COMMENT BOX APPEARS, THERE IS A CHECK BOX TO THE GRANTOR TO SELECT YES OR NO TO SEND AN E_MAIL.

PRIOR TO THE SYSTEM BUILD CHANGE WERE SENT AUTOMATICALLY.

FIGURE 2 SHOWS THE E_MAIL TO APPLICANT AND SPACE WHERE COMMENTS MADE BY THE GRANTOR WILL APPEAR.
