### **NEW PARTNERSHIP FOR REFORM**

- The Department of Education will be a partner with States developing ESEA Flexibility plans
  - Supporting innovation and reform in the states
  - Maintaining a high bar for the success of all students
- The Department will support States in multiple ways
  - Providing States information and assistance to submit a complete request
  - Helping States think through comprehensive reforms that will support great teaching and help all students achieve success

### **MULTIPLE PATHWAYS TO REFORM**

- There is not one right way to meet the ESEA Flexibility principles
  - States are already advancing a variety of innovations to support education reforms
  - The Department will work with States to meet the principles based on each State's context
- There is not one right timeline for requesting flexibility
  - States that are ready will be able to get started immediately
  - States that need time to put the foundations in place will have multiple chances to submit requests and receive assistance

## **TIMELINES FOR SUBMISSION**

- Submit request by **November 14, 2011** for December peer review
- Submit request by **mid-February, 2012** for a Spring 2012 peer review
- If States need additional time to submit for the full flexibility package, there will be an additional request window following the 2011-2012 school year

#### **REVIEW PROCESS**

- Peer Review
  - State requests will be evaluated by expert peer reviewers
  - A State will have opportunities to clarify its flexibility request for reviewers and to answer reviewer questions
  - Peer reviewer evaluations will inform the Secretary's decisions to grant flexibility to States
- Continuing Engagement with States
  - The Department will provide feedback about components of the request that need additional development
  - States will receive continuing technical assistance and additional opportunities for peer review
