## **Public Notice of Voluntary Liquidation**

Notice must be made for a period of two months in every issue of a newspaper published in the city or town in which the bank is located, or if no newspaper is there, then in the newspaper published nearest to the bank's location.

## Example:

This notice is given pursuant to 12 USC 182 that (exact corporate name and address (street, city, county, state) of national bank) is closing its business voluntarily. Notice also has been given to the Comptroller of the Currency, (address of the district office), of its plan to liquidate.

The bank is closing its affairs. Any creditor should present its claim for payment against the bank by (*insert date that is no earlier than 14 calendar days after the date of the final newspaper publication of this notice*) either by mail to (*mailing address*) or in person to (*street address*).
