Common or Abundant; present in large numbers.

Fairly common; present in moderate numbers.

Uncommon; present in small numbers.

Rare; present in very small numbers; often highly localized.

Very rare; three or fewer occurrences per season; may not be

present every year.

Casual: record outside of usual season of occurrence.

Variable; may be present in a given area one year, rare or absent the next.
