COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FEE RATE ADVISORY #8

On October 27, Congress passed and the President signed a one-day extension, through October 28, 2000, of the current continuing resolution. Presently, we are operating under a continuing resolution through October 30, 2000, and it is anticipated that additional extensions will be passed over the next several days. Until the SEC receives a permanent appropriation for fiscal 2001, the fee rate on filings made pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Securities Act of 1933 will remain at the current rate of \$264 per \$1,000,000. Please note that when an appropriations bill is enacted, the fee rate will decrease to \$250 per \$1,000,000.

We will issue further notices as appropriate to keep filers and registrants informed of developments affecting the Section 6(b) fee rate. This information will be posted at the SEC's Internet website at http://www.sec.gov.

RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

ADOPTION OF PROXY STATEMENT AND INFORMATION STATEMENT HOUSEHOLDING RULE AMENDMENTS

The Commission has issued a release adopting rule amendments to the proxy rules under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The amendments permit companies, banks and broker-dealers to satisfy the delivery requirements for proxy statements and information statements with respect to two or more security holders sharing the same address by delivering a single proxy statement or information statement to those security holders. This method of delivery, often referred to as "householding," will reduce the amount of duplicative information that security holders receive and lower printing and mailing

costs for companies. The amendments also modify the rules for householding annual reports and amend Rule 154 under the Securities Act of 1933 to permit householding of proxy statements combined with prospectuses. Publication of the release is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 30. (Rels. 33-7912; 34-43487; IC-24715)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

SEC OBTAINS FEDERAL COURT INJUNCTION AND BARS FORMER BROKER

The Commission announced that on September 11, 2000, the Honorable Stanley S. Harris, United States District Judge for the District of Columbia, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief as to defendant David W. Benner (Benner) in a case involving a fraudulent scheme to offer and sell debt securities to the investing public for the purpose of raising capital to finance the purported medical accounts receivable factoring operations of an entity known as Current Financial Services, Inc. (Current). Benner consented to the entry of the Final Judgment, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, except as to personal and subject matter jurisdiction, which he admitted.

The Final Judgment restrains and enjoins Benner from committing future violations of Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Final Judgment, among other things, also orders Benner to disgorge \$18,938.95.67, comprised of \$9,613.17, representing the commissions he earned from his offer and sale of American Equity debt securities, plus \$9,325.78, representing prejudgment interest thereon, but waives payment and declines to impose civil penalties based on Benner's demonstrated inability to pay.

The Commission also announced that on October 27, 2000, it entered an administrative order related to Benner's conduct described in the Complaint. Benner consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, to an Order barring Benner from association with any broker or dealer, with the right to reapply after one year. [SEC v. SEC v. GENE GARLAND, JR., INDIVIDUALLY AND DOING BUSINESS AS ASSOCIATION FOR RETIRED PERSONS FINANCIAL SERVICES AND SHARLA HOLLAND

The Commission announced that on October 20 Judge Joe Kendall, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Texas, granted the Commission's request for a judgment by default against Gene Irving Garland, Jr., individually and doing business as Association for Retired Persons Financial Services (RPFS). The Commission's complaint alleged that Garland and Sharla Dawn Holland defrauded approximately 60 elderly individuals of approximately \$1.8 million. The Court's order permanently enjoins Garland from future violations of the antifraud and securities registration provisions of the federal securities laws and directs Garland to pay \$1,710,674.07 in disgorgement, plus \$319,807.87 in prejudgment interest, and \$15,877 in civil penalties. Garland currently is awaiting trial on a 127 count federal criminal indictment alleging securities fraud, mail fraud and money laundering.

In its complaint, the Commission alleged that Garland and Holland violated Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Under the guise of providing estate and financial planning services, the defendants solicited information about the senior Upon obtaining this information, the defendants citizens' assets and investments. encouraged the senior citizens to liquidate their legitimate investments and individual retirement accounts and to use the proceeds to purchase "annuities" issued by RPFS purportedly paying 11 percent interest. Concealed from investors, however, were the facts that RPFS had minimal business operations and insufficient revenue to pay the promised interest rate and that Garland and Holland used funds from later investors to make principal and interest payments to earlier investors, as well as for their own personal uses. Garland and Holland allegedly misappropriated at least \$900,000 of the funds raised from the defrauded senior citizens. [SEC v. PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST TUTORNET.COM GROUP, INC. AND EUBURN R.A. FORDE

On October 23, the Honorable Leonie M. Brinkema of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia entered an Agreed Order of Permanent Injunction against defendants Tutornet.com Group, Inc. (Tutornet) and Euburn R. A. Forde (Forde), Tutornet's president. The Order permanently enjoins Tutornet and Forde from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder; permanently enjoins Tutornet from violating Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-11 and 13a-13 thereunder; and permanently enjoins Forde from aiding and abetting violations of Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-11 and 13a-13 thereunder. The Order also requires Tutornet to file with the Commission within 30 days, (a) an amended Form 8-K, which shall correct statements made therein concerning America Online, Inc. and Princeton Investments, Ltd.; and (b) an amended Form 10-K for the period ending June 30, 2000 which shall include a statement of cash flows. Finally, the Order requires Forde to pay a civil money penalty in the amount of \$55,000. Tutornet and Forde consented to the entry of the Order, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint.

On August 29, 2000 the Commission filed an injunctive action against Tutornet and Forde. The Commission's complaint alleged that Tutornet and Forde made false and misleading statements, and omitted to state material information, in a Form 8-K filed with the Commission on May 18, 2000, and in a January 2000 letter to shareholders published on Tutornet's website, in an effort to lull current and prospective investors into a false sense of security in the face of Tutornet's precarious financial condition. The complaint also alleged that Tutornet's Form 10-Q filed with the Commission on August 21, 2000 was deficient because it failed to include a statement of cash flow. [SEC v.
