ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST JERRY WOMACK

On November 13, the Commission filed an action in federal district court in Los Angeles against Jerry A. Womack. The Commission alleges that Womack committed securities fraud in offering and selling \$19 million in securities to about 400 investors nationwide, between August 1997 and June 1999. The complaint alleges that Womack represented to investors that he would invest their money in the stock market and that he had retained traders on the floor of the New York Stock Exchange to assist in his trading. Womack also represented to investors that the trading activity was yielding profits. In fact, Womack utilized only about a quarter of the investors' money for trading and suffered a net loss on that trading. The complaint further alleges that Womack misused the majority of investor funds for personal and unrelated expenses and to pay some investors their purported profits and principal. The complaint charges Womack with violating the registration provisions of the Securities Act, and the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and the Investment Advisers Act and seeks an injunction, the payment of disgorgement, prejudgment interest and civil penalties. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-NASD-00-65) filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers relating to Rule 10334 of the NASD Code of Arbitration Procedure has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-00-48) submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers requiring public disclosure of an issuer's receipt of a delisting notice. PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-00-12) under Section 19(b)(1) of the Exchange Act. The proposed rule change would allow DTC to combine its TradeSuite family of institutional trade processing services with the institutional trade processing services offered by Thomson Financial ESG in a proposed joint venture between The Depository Trust & Clearing Corporation (DTCC), Thomson Information Services Inc., and Interavia, A.G. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 13. (Rel. 34-43541)

JOINT INDUSTRY PLAN

The Commission is proposing pursuant to Section 12(f) of the Securities Exchange Act to expand the number of eligible securities that may be traded by a national securities exchange pursuant to the Joint Transaction Reporting Plan for the Nasdaq/National Market Securities Traded on an Exchange on an Unlisted or Listed Basis to include all Nasdaq/National Market Securities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 13. (Rel. 34-43545)
