COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTION

COMPLAINT NAMES JAREAN ETABLISSEMENT AND JACK E. ANDREWS. The SEC San Francisco Branch Office announced on December 7 the filing of a complaint in the Federal court in California seeking to enjoin Jarean Etablissement, a Liechtenstein corporation, and Jack E. Andrews, of Pebble Beach, Calif., from violations of the antifraud provisions of the Federal securities laws in connection with the redemption of shares of registered investment companies and gold mining companies held for the accounts of various investors. Appointment of a receiver is also sought. (LR-5668)

AMERICAN BIOCULTURE ENJOINED. The SEC announced on December 21 that the Federal court in New York had permanently enjoined American Bioculture, Inc. from violations of the antifraud, proxy and reporting provisions of the Federal securities law with regard to placing of funds of American Bioculture for compensating balances for loans. The company consented to the court order without admitting or denying the allegations. (LR-5675)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PITTWAY CORPORATION. The SEC has issued an order exempting proposed transactions pursuant to which Valois, S.A., a French corporation, and Perfect-Ventil GmbH, a German corporation, two subsidiaries of Pittway Corporation (controlled by Standard Shares, Inc., a registered investment company) would enter into certain licensing and purchasing agreements relating to their manufacturing and selling operations. STATE STREET INVESTMENT CORPORATION. The SEC has issued an order exempting State Street Investment Corporation of Boston, Massachusetts from the provisions of Section 22(d) of the Act to the extent that such Section might prohibit the Corporation, which does not have a current prospectus that states a current offering price, from issuing its shares, without any sales load, in exchange for the assets of Sego Trading Company, of Red Bank, New Jersey. MASSACHUSETTS INVESTORS GROWTH STOCK FUND. The SEC has issued an order permitting the sale of shares of Massachusetts Investors Growth Stock Fund, Inc., of Boston, Massachusetts, without a sales charge, in exchange for the assets of Planters Cotton Oil Mill, Inc., a personal holding company. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MICHIGAN POWER COMPANY. The SEC has issued an order upon an application of American Electric Power Company, Inc., and its public-utility subsidiary company, Michigan Power Company, granting an increase in the authorized amount of open-account advances from the holding company to the subsidiary company and an extension to December 31, 1973, of the time during which such advances and certain bank borrowings by the subsidiary company may be made.
