## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### WEEKLY CALENDAR

The following is a schedule of speaking engagements, Congressional testimony, Commission hearings and other public events involving the Commission for the week of January 18. (Commission Meetings are announced separately in the News Digest.)

#### Thursday, January 21

- \* David S. Ruder, Chairman of the Commission, will address the Securities Regulation Institute on enforcement matters on January 21, 1988. Chairman Ruder's talk will be at noon (Pacific Coast time). The Institute's meeting is in San Diego (Coronado Beach), California, at the Hotel del Coronado.

Others from the Commission scheduled to attend the Securities Regulation Institute are: Daniel Goelzer, General Counsel; Richard Ketchum, Director, Division of Market Regulation; Gary Lynch, Director, Division of Enforcement; Kathryn B. McGrath, Director, Division of Investment Management; and Linda C. Quinn, Director, Division of Corporation Finance.

#### MARIANNE K. SMYTHE APPOINTED ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR, DIVISION OF INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT

Chairman Ruder announced the appointment of Marianne K. Smythe as Associate Director (Regulation) in the Division of Investment Management. Ms. Smythe will be responsible for the Division's Offices of Investment Company Regulation, Regulatory Policy, and Public Utility Regulation. Ms. Smythe succeeds Gerald Osheroff, who retired in December 1987.

Ms. Smythe has been an Attorney Fellow in the Division since July 1987. Before joining the Division's staff, she was Professor of Law and Assistant Provost at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, where she taught for six years. Prior to joining the University of North Carolina faculty, she was Deputy Director of the Commodity Futures Trading Commission in 1980-81; Associate General Counsel (Pesticides) of the Environmental Protection Agency in 1980; and previously worked for the SEC as an Assistant Director and Branch Chief in the Division of Market Regulation, Special Assistant to the Director of the Special Study of the Options Markets, and as a staff attorney in the Division of Enforcement. Ms. Smythe obtained a B.S. degree in Biology from Bucknell University in 1963, and a J.D., with honors, from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Law School in 1974. She is a member of the District of Columbia bar.

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### COMPLAINT NAMES HUNTER MACK BELTON, OTHERS

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices filed a civil injunction action on December 22, 1987 in the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida against Hunter Mack Belton of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil; Milton Brown and John R. Zurn of Seminole, Florida; and Francis M. Wells, Jr. and Robert W. Mette', of St. Petersburg, Florida. The Complaint seeks to restrain and enjoin defendants from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws and to obtain an accounting of monies raised and disgorgement of ill-gotten gains.

The Complaint alleges that defendants: (1) offered and sold approximately \$5 million of unregistered securities, in the form of interests in a Brazilian entity known as a "limitada" [the limitada purportedly operated a gold mine in Brazil]; (2) without registering as broker-dealers, conducted group sales presentations through the country to market the investments; and (3) made misrepresentations and omissions of material facts in connection with the offer and sale of the securities including, among others, that the limitada had proven gold reserves totalling \$5-6 million, that the investments

were exempt from registration, that the mine was currently producing over \$2 million in gold per day, and that the investment involved little or no risk. (SEC v. Hunter Mack Belton, et al., Civil Action No. 87-1890-CIV-T-13C, MDFL). (LR-11644)

#### INJUNCTIONS ENTERED IN COLONIAL X-RAY MATTER

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on December 22, 1987 Judge William C. O'Kelley, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Anthony Peter Strangie of Woburn, Massachusetts, former president of Colonial X-Ray Corporation. The injunction prohibits violations of the antifraud, issuer reporting, and books and records provisions. Previously, on September 25, 1987, Judge O'Kelley entered a Permanent Injunction against the other defendant, Myer Spector of Milton, Massachusetts, former Colonial X-Ray controller. Defendants consented to the injunctions without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's September 1, 1987 complaint.

The Complaint alleges that Colonial X-Ray's registration statement for the offer and sale of its common stock was false and misleading in that its sales and revenues were overstated because orders for goods were recorded as sales. It further alleges that Strangie aided and abetted Colonial's failure to file or timely file annual and quarterly reports and notifications of inability to timely file reports. It also alleges that Strangie and Spector aided and abetted Colonial's violations of the books and records provisions of the Securities Exchange Act and that Strangie made misleading statements to the accountants concerning the preparation and filing of the registration statement. (SEC v. Anthony Peter Strangie, et al., USDC NDGA, Civil Action No. C87-1952A). (LR-11645)

#### COMPLAINT NAMES JOSEPH SIERCHIO

The Commission filed a Complaint on January 14 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Joseph Sierchio alleging that he violated Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 in connection with his trading in the securities of Waldbaum, Inc.

The Commission's Complaint alleges that on November 26, 1986, after the close of trading, the Great Atlantic & Pacific Tea Company (A&P) announced a tender offer for Waldbaum at \$50 per share. On November 23, 1986, the Chairman of Waldbaum telephoned Sierchio to request delivery of the Sierchios' Waldbaum stock certificates. In the course of that conversation, the Chairman of Waldbaum discussed with Sierchio a contemplated transaction involving the sale of Waldbaum. Sierchio, directly or indirectly, while in possession of material nonpublic information, either placed purchase orders or caused his broker to execute pre-existent purchase orders for 2,500 shares of Waldbaum common stock.

Simultaneous with the filing of the action, Sierchio, without admitting or denying the Complaint's allegations, consented to a permanent injunction against future violations, and agreed to disgorge \$63,978.24, and to pay a penalty of \$59,229.97 under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984. (SEC v. Joseph Sierchio, USDC SDNY, 88 Civ. 0253). (LR-11647)
