## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT APPEAL OF FRED WILLIAMS

The General Counsel sent a letter to Fred Williams affirming in part and reversing in part the Freedom of Information Act Officer's determination to withhold opening and closing reports of an investigation by the Commission of Sunset Minerals, Inc. The General Counsel determined that the reports may be withheld pursuant to FOIA Exemption 5, 5 USC 552(b)(5) and 16 CFR 200.80(b)(5), and FOIA Exemption 7(C), 5 USC 552(b)(7)(C) and 17 CFR 200.80(b)(7)(C), but that portions would nevertheless be released as an exercise of the General Counsel's discretion.

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

### RESERVE BANK ACCOUNT PROCEEDING RESOLVED

The Commission entered, by consent of the Respondents, an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions in an administrative proceeding previously authorized against Underwood, Neuhaus & Co., Inc., a registered Houston, Texas broker-dealer, and George Donehoo and William Merritt, persons associated with Underwood as its Operations Manager and Assistant Operations Manager, respectively, during the pertinent period in 1985. Underwood was found to have violated, and Donehoo and Merritt to have aided and abetted violations of, Sections 8(b) and 15(c) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 as well as Rules 8c-1, 15c2-1, and 15c3-3 by unlawfully hypothecating an average of \$6 million of customer's fully-paid and excess margin securities, and by failing to maintain required deposits in Underwood's Reserve Bank Account for the Exclusive Benefit of Customers.

With respect to the latter violations, the Commission found that Underwood paid down certain loans secured by customer securities on the one day only as of which it was required to compute reserve bank account balances, under-depositing on the six days tested by an average of \$3 million. Each respondent was censured and was ordered to comply with certain undertakings. (Rel. 34-25531)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
