INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

INSURED MUNICIPALS-INCOME TRUST

An order has been issued on an application of Insured Municipals-Income Trust and Investors' Corporate-Income Trust, both registered under the Investment Company Act of 1940 as unit investment trusts, their sponsor, Van Kampen Sauerman, Inc. and Dain, Kalman & Quail, Inc., a co-sponsor of one of the trusts, amending an earlier order dated January 31 (Rel. IC-10109) exempting an exchange offer by the two unit investment trusts from the provisions of Section 22(d) of the Act pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Act, and permitting that exchange offer to be effected on a basis other than the trusts' net asset value per unit at the time of exchange pursuant to Section 11 of the Act. INVESTORS' MUNICIPAL-YIELD TRUST, SERIES 1

An order has been issued on an application of Investors' Municipal-Yield Trust, Series 1 (and Subsequent Series), registered under the Investment Company Act of 1940 as a unit investment trust, and its Sponsor, Van Kampen Sauerman Inc., (a) pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Act, exempting Applicants from the provisions of Sections 14(a) and 22(d) of the Act, and Rules 19b-1 and 22c-1 under the Act, and (b) pursuant to Section 11 of the Act permitting the Trust to offer its units at net asset value plus a fixed dollar sales charge in certain exchange offers under a conversion option. A CORPORATE TRUST, SERIES 1
