# GRANT OF EXEMPTIVE RELIEF FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE TENDER OFFER REGULATIONS

The Commission granted an exemptive order from certain provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) to Global TeleSystems Group, Inc. with regard to a tender offer for the Ordinary Shares and American Depositary Shares of Esprit Telecom Group plc. The order granted relief from certain withdrawal rights provisions of Section 14(d)(5) of the Exchange Act and Rules 14d-7. For further information contact Laurie Green at (202) 942-2920. ## INTERNATIONAL DISCLOSURE HARMONIZATION

The Commission has issued a release soliciting public comment on proposed amendments to Form 20-F to incorporate the International Disclosure Standards recently endorsed by the International Organization of Securities Commissions. Form 20-F is used by foreign private issuers as a registration statement and annual report form under the Securities Act of 1934. The proposed amendments would bring the Commission's non-financial statement disclosure requirements for foreign private issuers more in line with international norms, thereby reducing the burden on issuers seeking to offer or list securities in multiple capital markets. The proposal would not change the financial statement reconciliation requirements for foreign issuers. The proposal includes amendments to the registration statement forms under the Securities Act of 1933 used by foreign private issuers and related rules and forms, which would be triggered by the proposed changes to Form 20-F. The Commission also is proposing to amend the definition of "foreign private issuer" to clarify how foreign issuers should determine their U.S. ownership for purposes of that definition. #### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

SEC SUES DONNKENNY, INC. AND FOUR FORMER SENIOR EXECUTIVES AND EMPLOYEES FOR FINANCIAL FRAUD

On February 2, the Commission filed two related enforcement actions: The first, filed in District Court for the District of Columbia, charged four former senior executives and employees of Donnkenny, Inc.(a manufacturer and marketer of women's sportswear and other apparel (with perpetrating a financial fraud at the company and engaging in illegal insider trading. The second was a settled administrative proceeding against the company.

The complaint against the individuals alleged that: Beginning in at least early 1994 and continuing until at least August 1996. Donnkenny's former chief executive officer and chairman, Richard F. Rubin, fraudulently managed the company's reported revenues and earnings. Rubin directed a scheme whereby the company improperly reported revenue both on bogus transactions as well as on sales before they occurred. Assisting Rubin in the scheme were three company employees: Donnkenny's former chief financial officer, Edward T. Creevy, its former controller, Ronald H. Hollandsworth, and former assistant controller, Kymberlee W. Kulis. While aware that the company's publicly reported financial results were materially misstated, Rubin, Creevy, Hollandsworth, and Kulis each also engaged in illegal insider trading by selling Donnkenny securities.

Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, Kulis agreed to settle the charges against her by consenting to a final judgment. The final judgment will prohibit Kulis from violating or aiding and abetting or causing violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Sections 10(b), 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A), 13(b)(2)(B), and 13(b)(5) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, 13a-1, 13a-13, and 13b2-1 thereunder. The judgment will also order Kulis to pay \$34,576.66, representing disgorgement of her trading profits and losses avoided (plus prejudgment interest thereon) and civil money penalties. [SEC v. Also simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, the Commission instituted an administrative proceeding against Donnkenny. Without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, Donnkenny consented to an order finding that the company violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Exchange Act as well as the periodic reporting, books and records, and internal accounting control provisions of the Exchange Act. The order directed Donnkenny to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations or future violations of the following provisions: Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, and Sections 10(b), 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A), and 13(b)(2)(B) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, 13a-1, and 13a-13 thereunder. # SEC SUES WIFE OF SCHOLASTIC CORPORATION EXECUTIVE AND HER CO-WORKER FOR INSIDER TRADING IN SCHOLASTIC CORPORATION OPTIONS

The Commission announced today that it filed an insider trading action against two real estate brokers, Donna Yun, of Longwood, Florida and Jerry Burch, of Heathrow, Florida. The complaint alleges that on February 18, 1997, Yun learned from her husband, an officer of Scholastic Corporation (Scholastic), material non-public

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information about an unanticipated earnings announcement bv Scholastic: that it expected to post a loss of 20-30 cents per share for the guarter ending February 28, 1997. Her husband also told her that he expected the share price of Scholastic common stock, which was trading at approximately \$65, to decline to \$55 per share as a result of the announcement. Yun's husband told her this information with the understanding that she would hold it in confidence. The complaint alleges further that at a cocktail party that evening Yun disclosed to Burch, a co-worker, her husband's prediction regarding a decline in Scholastic's stock price and the reasons for that On February 19 and 20, 1997, Burch purchased 130 prediction. Scholastic put option contracts, including 10 February series contracts which expired on February 21, 1997, and 90 put option contracts with a strike price of \$60 or below.

Scholastic's announcement concerning its loss for the quarter was released publicly after the close of trading on February 20, 1997. That day, Scholastic common stock closed before the announcement at \$61.50 per share. The following day, the price of Scholastic common stock dropped approximately 40 per cent, and closed at \$36.75 per share. On February 21, Burch exercised his put options for a net profit of approximately \$269,000.

The Commission is seeking permanent injunctions against Donna Yun and Jerry Burch from violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, as well as disgorgement of Jerry Burch's illegal profits, prejudgment interest and civil penalties.

# INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

#### HORACE MANN MUTUAL FUNDS AND WILSHIRE ASSOCIATES INCORPORATED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by Horace Mann Mutual Funds and Wilshire Associates Incorporated for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 15(a) of the Act and Rule 18f-2 under the Act, and from certain disclosure requirements under the Act. The order would permit applicants to enter into and materially amend investment management agreements with subadvisers without shareholder approval, and grant relief from certain disclosure requirements. #### GRADISON GROWTH TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 25 to request a hearing on an application filed by Gradison Growth Trust, et al. for an order exempting applicants from Section 15(a) of the Investment Company Act. The order would permit the implementation, without prior shareholder approval, of a new investment subadvisory agreement for a period commencing on the later of the date on which the sale of a controlling interest of the subadviser is consummated or the date the requested order is issued and continuing until the subadvisory agreement is approved or disapproved by shareholders of the investment company (but in no event later than March 22, 1999) (Interim Period). The order also would permit, following shareholder approval, the payment to the subadviser of all fees it earns under the subadvisory agreement during the Interim Period. (Rel. # FRANKLIN GOLD FUND, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application field by Franklin Gold Fund, et al. under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act (Act) exemption applicants from Sections 12(d)(1)(A) and (B) of the Act, under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act, and under Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 under the Act to permit certain joint transactions. The order permits certain registered management investment companies and private accounts to invest their uninvested cash and cash collateral in money market funds and engage in certain transactions with each other. The order also amends a prior order. (Rel. IC-23675 - February 2)

### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

#### ROCHESTER GAS AND ELECTRIC HOLDCO

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 22 to request a hearing on a proposal by Rochester Gas and Electric HoldCo (Holdco), a wholly owned subsidiary of Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation, a gas and electric public utility company (RG&E). Holdco intends to acquire RG&E and requests an order granting it an exemption under Section 3(a)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act (Act) from all provisions of the Act, except Section 9(a)(2). ## POTOMAC EDISON COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 22 to request a hearing on a proposal by Potomac Edison Company (Potomac Edison), a public utility subsidiary of Allegheny Energy Inc., a registered holding company. Potomac Edison proposes, through December 31, 2001, to invest up to \$250,000 to engage in

preliminary development activities in connection with a joint venture project to develop a business and technology park. (Rel. 35-26970)

## AMEREN CORP., ET AL.
