### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

### REVIEW PROCEEDING OF TRANSNET CORPORATION DISMISSED

The Commission upheld the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc.'s decision to delist TransNet Corporation from the Nasdaq Stock Market, Inc. National Market. During 1994, 1995 and 1996, TransNet had failed to comply with rules which require listed companies to hold annual shareholder meetings. In December 1997, a Nasdaq listings panel granted TransNet an exception permitting it to remain listed provided it held a shareholder meeting by January 30, 1998. TransNet failed to comply with the exception. TransNet also failed to explain to Nasdaq staff or Review Council why, despite strong assurances that it would be held on March 12, the shareholder meeting was rescheduled to April 2. # COMMISSION ISSUES CEASE AND DESIST ORDER AGAINST SPACEDEV, INC. AND JAMES BENSON

On April 13, the Commission entered an Order Making Findings and Imposing a Cease and Desist Order (Order) in a matter involving SpaceDev, Inc. (SpaceDev) a microcap company based in San Diego, California, and its chairman James William Benson (Benson), finding that SpaceDev and Benson made false and misleading statements to the public pertaining to projected 1998 revenues and earnings and a financing agreement with a broker-dealer. SpaceDev, whose stock is quoted on the OTC Bulletin Board, and Benson consented, without admitting or denying the allegations therein, to the entry of the Order, which prohibits them from violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. # DEFENDANTS PERMANENTLY ENJOINED IN MULTIMILLION DOLLAR OIL AND GAS OFFERING FRAUD CASE; DISGORGEMENT AND CIVIL PENALTIES ORDERED

The Commission announced that following a bench trial, on April 2, the Honorable Christina A. Snyder, United States District Judge for the Central District of California, entered a Final Judgment Of Permanent Injunction And Other Relief Against Defendants Peter Sacker, Jerry W. Anderson and Robert M. Kerns, enjoining them from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and Exchange Act and granting other relief. Previously, on May 18, 1998, the Court had entered an Order Granting Partial Summary Judgment, in which it found that, in a Ponzi-like scheme, the Defendants had defrauded over 500 investors, many of whom are elderly, of between \$16 million and \$19 million in at least 18 offerings of interests in oil and gas leases and wells made between 1992 and 1997.

In addition to the entry of the injunction, the Defendants have further each been ordered to disgorge their ill-gotten gains of \$643,113 (Sacker), \$981,625 (Anderson) and \$204,580 (Kerns), together with prejudgment interest thereon. Additionally, each Defendant has been ordered to pay a maximum third tier civil penalty equalling his gross pecuniary gains in the five years prior to the action being brought of \$551,845 (Sacker), \$822,781 (Anderson) and \$167,150 (Kerns). ### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### THE BRINSON FUNDS, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by The Brinson Funds, et al. under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order permits in-kind redemptions of shares of certain registered investment companies by certain affiliated persons of the investment companies. (Rel. IC-23781 - April 13)

### TODD INVESTMENT ADVISORS, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Todd Investment Advisors, Inc. (Todd) granting an exemption from Section 15(a) of the Investment Company Act. The order permits the implementation, without prior shareholder approval, of a new investment sub-advisory agreement (New Agreement) for a period of not more than 150 days beginning on the later of the date on which the acquisition by Fort Washington Investment Advisors, Inc. of Todd is consummated or the date on which the requested order is issued and continuing through the date the New Agreement is approved or disapproved by the shareholders (but in no event later than September 9, 1999) (Interim Period). The order would also permit payment of all fees earned under the New Agreement during the Interim Period following

shareholder approval. (Rel. IC-23783 - April 13)

## PROTECTIVE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act to Protective Life Insurance Company (Protective Life), American Foundation Life Insurance Company (American Foundation), Protective Variable Life Separate Account (Life Account), Protective Variable Annuity Separate Account (Annuity Account), and Variable Annuity Account A of American Foundation (Account A). The order approves the substitution of shares of Oppenheimer Variable Account Funds representing interests in its Oppenheimer Money Fund for shares of Protective Investment Company representing interests in its Money Market Fund, which currently are held by the Life Account, Annuity Account and Account A to support variable life insurance contracts or variable annuity contracts issued by Protective Life or American Foundation.
