## **ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS**

## SEC CHARGES COMPANY INSIDER AND TWO FRIENDS WITH INSIDER TRADING

On June 15, the Commission filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia charging Brian Patrick Burns, Jr. and two longtime friends, Albert Joseph Pandolfi and Stanley Alvin Pandolfi, with insider trading in advance of an April announcement that Neurex Corp., a California public biopharmaceutical company, would be acquired by Elan Corporation, The complaint alleges that Burns, then an in-house attorney with Neurex, learned of the possible acquisition of his company on the morning of April 27, 1998. Later that day, Burns tipped Albert Pandolfi about the acquisition and recommended that Albert's father, Stanley Pandolfi, purchase Neurex stock. Both of the Pandolfis purchased Neurex common stock and call options on April 27, 1998. The Neurex acquisition was publicly announced before the opening of the market on April 29, 1998. As a result of the announcement, the price of Neurex's stock opened on April 29 at \$ 28.50, up \$8.75 from the previous day's close. Both Albert and Stanley Pandolfi sold their Neurex securities later that day, realizing total illicit profits of \$83,663. Burns did not purchase any Neurex securities prior to the announcement. The Commission alleges that as a result of the conduct described above, the defendants violated Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule permanent is seeking injunctions, thereunder, and disgorgement, and monetary penalties against the defendants.

All three defendants have consented to entry of final judgments permanently enjoining them from future violations of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, without admitting or denying the facts alleged in the complaint. Pursuant to the terms of their settlement agreements, Albert and Stanley Pandolfi will pay disgorgement in the amounts of \$15,000 and \$25,000 respectively, and based upon their demonstrated financial inability to pay additional amounts, \$43,663 in disgorgement will be waived and no civil penalties will be imposed. Burns has agreed to pay \$43,663 in disgorgement, representing the remainder of his tippees' profits; \$4,540 in prejudgment interest; and a civil penalty of \$43,663.

# SEC CHARGES FORMER PRICEWATERHOUSE COOPERS MANAGER FOR TIPPING FRIENDS ABOUT ACQUISITION OF PINKERTON'S, INC.

On June 15, the Commission filed an amended complaint in SEC v. Heden et al., an insider trading case pending in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, to add David Drescher as a defendant. The amended complaint alleges that Drescher, a former manager at PricewaterhouseCoopers' New York office, provided material, nonpublic information to two Swedish friends about the imminent acquisition of California based Pinkerton's, Inc., by Securitas AB, a Swedish security services company. At the time of his tips, Drescher was working on the PricewaterhouseCoopers team advising Securitas in connection with the deal. On February 22, 1999, Securitas and Pinkerton announced that Securitas intended to acquire Pinkerton through a cash tender offer. The complaint alleges that the Drescher and the other defendants who traded violated Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 thereunder. The Commission is seeking injunctive relief, disgorgement, and civil penalties against all defendants.

The complaint alleges that on a series of occasions, Drescher provided two Swedish college friends with information that enabled them to determine the identity of the acquiror, the target, and the date of the announcement. The complaint also alleges that on Friday, February 19, 1999, Drescher's friends and their tippees purchased a total of 14,400 shares of Pinkerton common stock at approximately \$17 per share. On the morning of the next trading day, Monday, February 22, 1999, Securitas and Pinkerton announced Securitas' plans to acquire Pinkerton through a \$29 per share cash tender offer. Pinkerton's stock price rose 69% to close at \$28.56 that day. The trading defendants sold their entire Pinkerton holdings that day.

On May 21, 1999, U.S. District Judge Shira Scheindlin issued a preliminary injunction continuing an asset freeze of most of the proceeds from the defendants' Pinkerton stock sales. The preliminary injunction froze over \$373,000 of sales proceeds, including approximately \$175,000 in allegedly unlawful profits. [SEC v. # SEC CHARGES CHRISTOPHER WOLF FOR DEFRAUDING CUSTOMERS IN STOCK SALES TOTALING \$7 MILLION

The Commission today filed a complaint against Christopher Wolf for orchestrating fraudulent sales of stock in Auxer Industries, Inc. (Auxer) from a New York City branch office of Vision Investment Group, Inc. (Vision), a now defunct, registered broker-dealer. The complaint, filed in the Eastern District of New York alleges as

From July through December, 1995, Wolf, who owned and operated the New York City branch office even though he was never registered with Vision, and other salespeople under his direction, defrauded Vision customers by making material misrepresentations about Auxer and baseless predictions about its stock price and purchasing Auxer stock for customer accounts without authorization. Wolf and others also failed to disclose that they received compensation for selling Auxer stock and that customer orders were being filled with Wolf's stock held in Vision accounts. proceeds from the fraudulent sales were approximately \$7 million. As a result of this conduct, Wolf violated Sections 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint seeks permanent injunctive relief; disgorgement of Wolf's ill-gotten gains plus prejudgment interest; and civil penalties. information, please contact Daniel J. #### SEC SUES DAVID HOUGE FOR FRAUD INVOLVING FOUR MICROCAP SECURITIES

The Commission today brought fraud charges against David Houge alleging his participation in manipulating three micro-cap companies: Auxer Industries, Inc. (Auxer), Legend Sports, Inc. (Legend), and Orlando Super Card, Inc. (Orlando) and the fraudulent sale of a private placement for City Services, Inc. (City Services).

The Commission's complaint, filed in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York, alleges as follows: For each of Auxer, Legend and Orlando, Houge controlled the supply of the stocks; raised the price through orchestrated trades; and paid undisclosed cash compensation to retail salespeople. For City Services, Houge similarly paid undisclosed compensation to retail salespeople. In the scheme related to Auxer, Houge also violated the registration provisions by using nominees for a purported offering under Rule 504 of Regulation D. Houge also acted as an undisclosed control person of First National Equity Corp., now-defunct registered broker-dealer, and as an officer of City Services. Total proceeds from the stock sales were approximately \$7 million for Auxer; \$6 million for Legend; \$4 million for Orlando; and \$1 million for City Services. As a result, Houge violated Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933; Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder; and is liable as a controlling person under Section 20(a) of the Exchange Act for First National's violations of Section 15(c) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-3 and 15c1-2 thereunder. The complaint seeks permanent injunctive relief; disgorgement of Houge's ill-gotten gains plus prejudgment interest; and an officer and director bar. Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, the Commission also filed a Partial Final Judgment on Consent, in which Houge, without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint, consented to the entry of all the injunctive relief sought in the complaint and an officer and director bar. #### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

#### PAINEWEBBER GROUP, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 6, 1999, to request a hearing on an application filed by PaineWebber Group, Inc. (PWG), et al., for an exemption from Sections 17(a) and 12(d)(3) of the Investment Company Act and for an order under Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 under the Act to permit certain joint transactions. The order would permit: (a) General Electric Company (GE), General Electric Capital Services, Inc., General Electric Capital Corporation, and GE Financial Assurance Holdings, (collectively, GE Issuers) to sell to and repurchase (i.e., prepay) from certain registered investment companies advised by affiliates of PWG (PWG Funds) commercial paper issued by the GE Issuers; (b) PWG Funds to purchase municipal obligations insured by the Financial Guaranty Insurance Company (FGIC), a subsidiary of GE, and/or insurance policies issued by FGIC on municipal obligations; and (c) PWG Funds to purchase in the secondary market common stock and other securities issued by GE and its subsidiaries. #### SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

## PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

MBS Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-MBSCC-99-02) under Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act. The proposed rule change: (i) implements the net-out report, (ii) modifies financial reporting by participants, (iii) modifies certain special provisions applicable to non domestic participants, (iv) requires additional assurances from MBSCC participants, and (v) clarifies MBSCC's role as agent in a liquidation. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 14. (Rel. 34-41516)

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-99-14) under Section 19(b)(1) of the Exchange Act. Under the proposed rule change, DTC will establish an automated foreign tax reclaim service that will assist its participants in preparing forms that are required to reclaim tax that is withheld on income payments on non-U.S. securities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 21. (Rel. 34-41525)

#### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-99-08) to amend its By-Laws and temporarily waive certain provisions of its shareholders agreement in order to

increase the size of its Board of Directors. The Commission has approved the proposed rule change on an accelerated basis. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 14. (Rel. 34-41520)

## IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> to enhance the Exchange's Automated Options Market System and to employ trade reporting terminals in certain options (SR-Phlx-99-11) has become immediately effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 14. (Rel. 34-41524)

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> relating to membership dues and fees (SR-CHX-99-02) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 21. (Rel. 34-41526)
