COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF TRADING ENTERED AGAINST SAGAMORE TRADING GROUP, INC.

The Commission announced the temporary suspension, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), of over the counter trading of the securities of Sagamore Trading Group, Inc. (Sagamore) of Roslyn, New York, at 9:30 a.m. EDT on July 14, 1999 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. EDT on July 27, 1999.

The Commission's Order of Suspension of Trading arose from concerns that there was a lack of current and accurate information regarding the securities of Sagamore because of recent market activity in the stock that may have been the result of manipulative conduct.

The Commission acknowledges the assistance of the National Association of Securities Dealers Regulation, Inc. in connection with this matter. (Rel. 34-41617)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ISSUED AGAINST FORMER KIDDER PEABODY BROKER IN YIELD-BURNING CASE

The Commission announced that it has issued a cease and desist order (Order) against Peter W. Zent, a former Kidder, Peabody & Co., Incorporated (Kidder) senior vice president, based on his conduct in a 1993 financing transaction for the City of Tampa, Florida (City). The Order finds that, as a result of material misrepresentations of fact by Zent, Kidder generated nearly \$3.5 million in wrongful profits through "yield burning": in this case, the purchase of an Escrow Reinvestment Agreement (Agreement) at below its fair market value in order to reduce the yield to the City.

The Order finds that Zent willfully violated Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder and directs Zent to cease and desist from such violations. The Order also imposes on Zent a monetary penalty of \$20,000 and suspends him from association with any broker or dealer for twelve months. Zent consented to issuance of the Order without admitting or denying the Order's factual findings.

The Order finds that in late 1993 Zent agreed to solicit bids on behalf of the City for the right to enter into the Agreement. The purpose of the Agreement was to provide the City with additional investment income on the proceeds of certain previously-issued, tax-exempt advance refunding bonds, which proceeds the City then held in escrow. The Order finds that, in addition to agreeing to solicit bids on the Agreement, Kidder entered its own bid, was declared the winning bidder and was awarded the Agreement in December 1993.

The Order finds that, in connection with the award of the Agreement, Zent made certain representations to the City regarding the bidding process and the value of the Agreement. The Order finds that Zent either knew or recklessly disregarded that these representations were false. Subsequent purchases and sales of securities under the Agreement generated profits of nearly \$3.5 million. Of this amount Kidder retained almost \$1.67 million, and transferred the balance, or \$1.78 million, to another entity that assisted Kidder in the transaction.

In a related matter, the Commission previously announced that it had instituted and simultaneously settled cease and desist proceedings against Kidder relating to the same transaction involved in the Order discussed above (see Rel. 34-41224, March 30, 1999).

In addition, a hearing is currently scheduled before an administrative law judge against another individual, Michael A. Cornblum, for his alleged role in this same transaction. The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether the staff's allegations in this matter are true as against Cornblum and, if so, whether a cease and desist order, disgorgement, monetary penalty or other sanction is appropriate against him (see Rel. 34-41225, March 30, 1999). OBSTRUCTION AND CRIMINAL CONTEMPT INDICTMENT RETURNED AGAINST KENNETH SENFFNER

The United States Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois returned an indictment against Kenneth Senffner (Senffner) of Clifton, Illinois on July 8 for influencing, obstructing, and impeding an action by the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission). United States v. Kenneth Senffner, 99 CR 0490 (N.D. Ill.). The indictment alleges that Senffner was a general partner of Clifton Capital Investors, L.P. (CCI), which was formed for the purpose of administering the Chicago Housing Authority's (CHA) early retirement program. In 1992 the Chicago Housing Authority provided approximately \$5.1 million in funding to Senffner and CCI. Senffner and CCI's other general partner, John Lauer, used the funds provided by the CHA to invest with Legacy Trust for trading in so-called prime bank instruments. The indictment alleges that Senffner was to benefit personally from the trading. The indictment further alleges that in 1994 the Commission began an investigation into the fraudulent offer and sale of investments in prime bank instrument trading, which included CCI's use of CHA funds to invest in prime bank instrument trading. In June 1994 the Commission filed a lawsuit, SEC v. Lauer, et al., 94 C 3770 (N.D. Ill.), against Senffner's partner, John Lauer, CCI, and others seeking an injunction prohibiting CCI from committing federal securities fraud violations, and freezing CCI's assets. A temporary restraining order was entered prohibiting the transfer, sale or other disposition of any assets belonging to the defendants. The indictment alleges that Senffner, after receiving notice of the temporary restraining order, and in violation of the order, willfully transferred a check made payable to CCI to a third party in Atlanta, Georgia, and failed to reverse or disclose the transfer. The indictment contains three counts, and alleges that Senffner's actions constitute criminal contempt and obstruction of the due and proper administration of justice. [U.S. v. Kenneth Senffner, 99 CR 0490, N.D. Ill.] (LR-16210)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW CENTURY ENERGIES, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by New Century Energies, Inc. (NCE), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned nonutility subsidiary, NC Enterprises, Inc. (Enterprises). Enterprises, through a new wholly owned subsidiary, New Century O&M Services, Inc. (NCO&M), proposes to bid on and, if successful, acquire facilities owned by the federal government on military enclaves which are used exclusively (i) in connection with the delivery and distribution of electricity, natural gas, water, steam and other energy products, and (ii) for the collection, treatment, processing and disposal of solid and liquid wastes (collectively, Military Base Assets). The order authorizes NCO&M to invest up to \$150 million in Military Base Assets through December 31, 2003. Initially, NCO&M is authorized to bid on Military Base Assets located at Fort Carson Post, near Colorado Springs, Colorado. The order reserves jurisdiction over the acquisition of any additional Military Base Assets by NCO&M. (Rel. 35-27048)
