RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

GRANT OF EXEMPTIVE RELIEF FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE TENDER OFFER REGULATIONS

The Commission granted an exemptive order from certain provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) to Vedior N.V. with regard to a tender offer for all of the outstanding ordinary shares and American Depositary Shares of Select Appointments (Holdings) plc. The order granted relief from certain withdrawal rights provisions of Section 14(d)(5) of the Exchange Act and Rules 14d-7 and 14d-10 thereunder, and confirmed that the offer could employ certain practices consistent with U.K. law and practice. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

INVESTMENT ADVISER AND ITS PRINCIPAL SANCTIONED FOR FALSE PERFORMANCE ADVERTISING

On September 13, the Commission instituted and settled cease and desist and administrative proceedings against Engebretson Capital Management, Inc. (ECMI), a registered investment adviser located in Newport Beach, California and its president and owner, Lester W. Engebretson (Engebretson). The Order finds that ECMI willfully violated, and Engebretson willfully aided and abetted and caused violations of, Sections 204, 206(1), 206(2) and 206(4) of the Investment Advisers Act and Rules 204-2(a)(11), 204-2(a)(16) and 206(4)-1(a)(5) thereunder. Specifically, the Order finds that from at least 1994 through mid-1998, ECMI and Engebretson distributed false and misleading documents that significantly overstated ECMI's performance results. The materials consisted of charts summarizing ECMI's performance history from 1973 forward, and questionnaires submitted to Nelson Information Inc. (Nelson), an independent rating service, containing performance results dating back to 1984. The materials failed to disclose that ECMI's performance from 1973 through 1994 did not represent the results of actual client trading, but instead reflected hypothetical transactions effected in a model account. Moreover, the returns reported by ECMI were not indicative of actual client performance and failed to deduct management fees normally charged to clients. Although ECMI began to report actual client performance in 1995, the adviser failed to include cash and cash equivalents in return calculations. As a result of these practices, ECMI overstated its annual performance by as many as 15 percentage points, and the inflated results propelled ECMI to the top of Nelson's published rankings.

The materials also misrepresented that ECMI's performance results were prepared in accordance with industry standards, when in fact they were not. In addition, ECMI misrepresented to Nelson that the adviser's performance was audited, and Engebretson made misleading statements concerning ECMI's performance during a published interview with an investment journal. Finally, ECMI and Engebretson violated books and records requirements by failing to maintain advertising materials and keep documents substantiating the adviser's performance calculations. Based on the above findings and the respondents' settlement offer, the Commission imposed a cease and desist order on ECMI and Engebretson, censured them, and ordered that ECMI pay a \$100,000 penalty and Engebretson pay a \$50,000 penalty. The Commission also ordered ECMI and Engebretson to comply with remedial undertakings that require an independent certified public accountant to audit ECMI's performance figures annually and review the adviser's advertising materials quarterly. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST AND SIMULTANEOUSLY SETTLED WITH DOMINIC SCACCI

On September 14, the Commission entered an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings Pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), Making Findings and

Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) against Dominic Scacci (Scacci) of West Palm Beach, Florida. The Commission simultaneously accepted Scacci's Offer of Settlement, in which he agreed to be barred from participating in any offering of a penny stock.

The Order alleged that on September 8 a final judgment of permanent injunction was entered against Scacci in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, SEC v. Omnigene Development, Inc. f/k/a Omnigene Diagnostics, Inc., et al., Case No. 98-8672-CIV-RYSKAMP (S.D. Fla.). The final judgment permanently enjoined Scacci from further violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

In its complaint against Scacci, the Commission alleged that from April 1996 through November 1996, in a classic "pump and dump" scheme, Scacci fraudulently inflated the price of ODI stock while selling shares into the public market. Specifically, Scacci made and caused ODI to make, misrepresentations concerning ODI's assets, revenues, business relationships and projected stock price in ODI's investor packages, press releases, radio broadcasts and Internet communications in violation of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. SEC FILES FRAUD ACTION AGAINST DISBARRED ATTORNEY AND ISSUES AN ORDER SUSPENDING HIM FROM APPEARING OR PRACTICING BEFORE THE SEC

The Commission announced that it filed fraud charges against Kevin James Quinn (Quinn), a disbarred attorney, and two entities he controls, Go Irish, Ltd. (Go Irish) and HMC Limited, LLC (HMC Limited). The SEC filed its complaint in the United States District Court for the Central District of California. The complaint filed by the SEC alleges that Quinn stole over 1.2 million shares of stock from two companies in which he served as an officer, director, and/or counsel. Quinn sold most of the stock in secondary market transactions. Quinn's scheme netted him more than \$200,000 in profits.

The SEC's complaint alleges that in 1997 and 1998, Quinn stole 960,000 shares of common stock of Atlantic Central Enterprises Limited and 300,000 shares of common stock of Advanced Laser Products, Inc., companies in which Quinn was an officer, director, and/or counsel. The complaint alleges that Quinn accomplished this theft by misusing his corporate positions with these two companies. The complaint alleges that Quinn (a) falsified board of directors' resolutions purportedly authorizing the issuance of the shares; (b) provided the fraudulent resolutions to the transfer agent and induced the transfer agent to issue the shares in the name of Quinn, Go Irish, HMC Limited, or a Canadian brokerage firm in which Quinn deposited the shares; and (c) either (i) sold shares into the market, or (ii) transferred the shares into other accounts in the U.S. and Canada. The complaint alleges that no registration statement was filed or in effect with the Commission and no exemption from registration was available for the shares that Quinn, Go Irish, and HMC Limited sold to the public. The complaint also

alleges that Quinn provided no consideration for the stock, and that the board of directors for the two companies did not authorize the issuance, offer, or sale of the stock.

The complaint alleges that Quinn, Go Irish, and HMC Limited violated Sections 5(a) and (c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint seeks permanent injunctions, disgorgement of Quinn's ill-gotten gains plus prejudgment interest, civil penalties, an accounting, and an officer and director bar.

The Commission also announced today that it issued an Order of Suspension Pursuant to Rule 102(e)(2) of the Rules of Practice against Kevin James Quinn. The Order suspends Quinn from appearing or practicing before the Commission based on his disbarment by the Supreme Court of California on September 19, 1997. [SEC v. COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST LELONG INVESTMENT GROUP, LLC AND JAMES MARINO FOR FRAUD AND SECURITIES REGISTRATION VIOLATIONS

On September 14, the Commission filed a complaint in federal court in Los Angeles against LeLong Investment Group, LLC (LeLong) and James A. Marino alleging violations of the antifraud and securities registration provisions of the federal securities laws. The complaint seeks permanent injunctions, civil penalties, and disgorgement of all profits derived from the fraudulent activities.

The complaint alleges that the defendants raised approximately \$300,000 from the offer and sale of two investments to about 26 investors. The first investment was a loan program to raise start-up expenses for LeLong; the second investment involved interests in a fund which would finance low budget films. The complaint alleges that the defendants misrepresented the existence of contracts and agreements with film companies as well as the existence of an insurance policy with Lloyd's of London. The defendants also failed to properly register interests in the fund with the Commission. [SEC v. LeLong Investment Group, LLC and James A. Marino, Civil Action No. CV 99-09304 JSL, RCx, C.D.
