ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IN THE MATTER OF SANDRA SIMPSON AND DAPHNE PATTEE

An administrative law judge issued an Initial Decision in the above-referenced matter. The law judge concluded that Respondents Sandra Simpson and Daphne Pattee willfully violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder (antifraud provisions) by engaging in a scheme to defraud Prudential customers. Specifically, the law judge found that, in addition to churning accounts, making unsuitable trades, and executing unauthorized margin trades, Respondents attempted to conceal their scheme by making false and misleading statements and causing unauthorized transfers between customer accounts.

The law judge ordered Respondents to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The decision also ordered that each Respondent be permanently barred from association with a broker-dealer, a member of a national securities exchange, or registered securities association. Additionally, the law judge imposed a \$100,000 civil money penalty against Sandra Simpson and a \$50,000 civil money penalty against Daphne Pattee. Finally, the law judge ordered Respondents to disgorge \$34,171 plus prejudgment interest. (Initial Decision No. 148; File No. 3-9458)

IN THE MATTER OF SEABOARD INVESTMENT ADVISERS, INC. AND EUGENE HANSEN

Chief Administrative Law Judge Brenda P. Murray issued an initial decision today in the above-referenced matter. The Commission's Order Instituting Public Proceedings (OIP) alleged that, among other things, on July 9, 1998, the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia entered an order by consent permanently enjoining Respondents from violating Sections 206(1), 206(2) and 206(4) of the Investment Advisers Act (Advisers Act) and Rule 206(4)-1(a)(5), and from violating the terms of a cease and desist order entered by the Commission against Seaboard and Hansen, among others, on August 3, 1994. In addition to being permanently enjoined, Hansen was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$50,000.

The administrative proceedings were instituted in order to determine whether the allegations in the OIP were true and, if so, whether remedial sanctions ought to be imposed against Respondents in the public interest. The Division of Enforcement recommended that Seaboard's investment adviser registration be revoked and that Hansen should be barred from association with an investment adviser. Chief Judge Murray concluded that it was in the public interest to revoke Seaboard's registration, but that it would be unduly harsh to bar Hansen from association with an investment adviser in light of certain mitigating factors. Instead, Chief Judge Murray suspended Hansen from association with an investment adviser for twelve months. (Initial Decision No. 149; File No. 3-9725)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, CESAR ODIO AND MANOHAR SURANA

On September 22, the Commission instituted public cease and desist proceedings pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against the City of Miami, Florida (City), and Cesar Odio (Odio) and Manohar Surana (Surana), both of Miami, Florida (collectively, the Respondents), to determine whether a cease and desist order should be imposed against them. The Order Instituting Public Cease and Desist Proceedings (Order) alleges that the City, through Odio and Surana, violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and Exchange Act in connection with the offer and sale to the public of securities in the form of municipal bonds issued by the City in June, August and December of 1995. The Order also alleges that the City, through Odio, violated the antifraud provisions when it disseminated its Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for fiscal year 1994 to the investing public in September 1995. A hearing will be held before an administrative law judge to determine whether the staff's allegations are true and, if so, whether a cease and desist order should be entered against the Respondents. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

TARGET/UNITED FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Target/United Funds, Inc. (Fund), and Waddell & Reed Investment Management Company (WRIMCO) from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Act, and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder, to permit shares of the Fund and any other similar investment company or investment company series that WRIMCO or any of its affiliates serve, now or in the future, as investment adviser, administrator, manager, principal underwriter or sponsor to be offered and sold to, and held by: (a) separate accounts funding variable annuity and variable life insurance contracts issued by both affiliated and unaffiliated life

insurance companies; and (b) qualified pension and retirement plans outside of the separate account context. (Rel. IC-24019 - September 20)

THE AMERICAN FRANKLIN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act to The American Franklin Life Insurance Company (American Franklin) and Separate Account VUL of American Franklin approving the substitution of securities issued by six newly-organized portfolios of EQ Advisors Trust (EQAT) for securities issued by six portfolios of The Hudson River Trust (HRT) and currently used as the underlying investment options for certain variable life insurance policies issued by American Franklin. (Rel. IC-24020 - September 21)

THE VICTORY PORTFOLIOS, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by The Victory Portfolios, et al. under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Sections 12(d)(1)(A) and 17(a) of the Act, and under Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 under the Act. The order amends a prior order that permits non-money market series of a registered open-end management investment company to purchase shares of one or more of the money market series of such registered investment company by adding a registered open-end management investment company and an investment adviser as applicants. (Rel. IC-24021 - September 21)

MITCHELL HUTCHINS SERIES TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Mitchell Hutchins Series Trust (Fund) and Mitchell Hutchins Asset Management Inc. (Mitchell Hutchins) from Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a), and 15(b) of the Act, and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder, to the extent necessary to permit shares of the Fund and similar investment companies for which Mitchell Hutchins, its parent, or any of their affiliates serve, now or in the future, as investment adviser, administrator, manager, principal underwriter or sponsor, and which offer their shares only to insurance company separate accounts, to be sold to and held by: (a) variable annuity and variable life insurance separate accounts of both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies; and (b) qualified pension and retirement plans outside of the separate account context. (Rel. IC-24022 - September 21)

THE UNION CENTRAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act to The Union Central Life Insurance Company, Carillon Account, and Carillon Life Account approving the substitution of:
(a) shares of the Balanced Index Portfolio of Carillon Fund for shares of the Capital Portfolio of Carillon Fund; and (b) shares of the AIM V.I. Capital Appreciation Fund of the AIM Fund for shares of the American Century VP Capital Appreciation Portfolio of American

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change, and granted accelerated approval to Amendment No. 1 of the proposed rule change, submitted by the <u>Pacific Exchange</u> (SR-PCX-99-16) requiring qualified off-floor traders for which the PCX is the Designated Examining Authority to successfully complete the General Securities Registered Representative Examination, Test Series 7. Publication of the order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of September 20. (Rel. 34-41881)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by <u>The Options Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-OCC-99-04) permitting OCC's clearing members to pledge long positions in non-proprietary cross margin accounts through OCC's pledge program. (Rel. 34-41883)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by <u>The Options</u> <u>Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-OCC-99-06) amending OCC's Certificate of Incorporation, By-Laws, and Stockholders Agreement with respect to the purchase of OCC stock by participant exchanges and the rights of those exchanges in the event of OCC's liquidation. The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by <u>The Depository Trust Company</u> (SR-DTC-99-10) adding a new service, Restricted Deposit Service, for the deposit and processing of restricted securities. (Rel. 34-41891)
