ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PLAN AND OPPORTUNITY FOR COMMENT BY THIRD PARTIES IN THE MATTER OF JOSEPH BARBATO

The Commission announced that on October 26 it gave notice that, pursuant to Rule 612 of the Rules of Practice of the Securities and Exchange Commission, 17 C.F.R. Section 201.612, the Division of Enforcement has filed its proposed Plan for the Distribution of Disgorged Funds (Distribution Plan) for In the Matter of Joseph J. Barbato. The Distribution Plan provides that \$45,142.00 representing profits in the form of commissions earned by Barbato from his fraudulent conduct, \$45,690.05 in prejudgment interest, and \$1,940.03 in postjudgment interest shall be paid to Barbato's customers who testified at the proceeding and were found by the Commission in its decision dated February 10, 1999, to have been defrauded. APPLICATION FOR REVIEW OF NASD'S DELISTING DETERMINATION DISMISSED

On October 25, the Commission dismissed an application for review of a decision of the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (NASD) denying the request of HealthTech International Inc. (HealthTech) to continue listing its securities on the Nasdaq SmallCap Market.

The NASD denied HealthTech continued listing because of concerns regarding the accuracy of HealthTech's financial statements. The NASD found, among other things, that HealthTech: (1) substantially overvalued pre-paid advertising credits that it reported as assets; (2) reported forgiveness of debt as extraordinary income when the debt forgiveness was not the result of an arms-length transaction; and (3) included as revenue a promissory note from a company that was in bankruptcy proceedings, rendering collection on the note unlikely. The Commission concluded that HealthTech's financial statements contained material misstatements and that its press releases were inaccurate. Moreover, the Commission found that HealthTech was seriously delinquent in filing its periodic reports. The Commission therefore dismissed HealthTech's appeal of the NASD's delisting determination. FINAL JUDGMENTS ENJOINING EDWARD BEAGAN AND CANCER MINUS, INC. FROM VIOLATING THE ANTIFRAUD PROVISIONS ENTERED IN SECURITIES FRAUD CASE

The Commission announced that on October 15 United States District Judge Richard M. Berman entered final judgments against Edward M. Beagan (Beagan) and Cancer Minus, Inc. (CMI). The Court entered these judgments after finding that Beagan and CMI violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rule 10b-5, the antifraud provisions, in connection with the sale of CMI common stock to investors.

The Court granted summary judgment against Beagan, and entered a default judgment against CMI because CMI failed to defend the action. In granting these motions, the Court found that Beagan, the president and chairman of CMI, disseminated materially misleading information about CMI and its purported cancer fighting products to investors. Specifically, Beagan told investors that CMI had developed an effective cancer drug and a diagnostic test, when no such drug or test existed. Beagan told investors that CMI was in negotiations with a major pharmaceutical company regarding licensing rights to CMI's products, when no such negotiations were occurring. Beagan also falsely stated that CMI would use investors' funds to develop and produce a cancer drug when, in fact, Beagan was using investors' funds to pay his personal expenses, among other things.

The Court granted the following relief against both defendants:

Beagan, age 56, of New York City, was permanently enjoined from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Beagan was ordered to disgorge his ill-gotten gains of \$324,700

together with pre-judgment interest of \$150,130. The Court also ordered Beagan to pay \$100,000 in civil penalties.

CMI, a New York corporation, was permanently enjoined from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. CMI was ordered to disgorge its ill-gotten gains of \$324,700 together with pre-judgment interest of \$150,130, and to pay a \$100,000 civil penalty, on a joint and several basis with Beagan. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MERRILL LYNCH, PIERCE, FENNER & SMITH INCORPORATED

An order has been issued on an application filed by Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith Incorporated (Merrill Lynch) exempting Exchangeable Preferred Trusts for which Merrill Lynch will serve as a principal underwriter (Trusts) from Sections 12(d)(1) and 14(a) of the Investment Company Act. The order permits other registered investment companies, and companies excepted from the definition of investment company under Sections 3(c)(1) and (c)(7) of the Act, to own a greater percentage of the total outstanding voting stock of the Trusts than that permitted by Section 12(d)(1) of the Act and exempts the Trusts from the initial net worth requirements of Section 14(a) of the Act. The order also amends a prior order. (Rel. IC-24111 - October 26)

J.P. MORGAN SECURITIES INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by J.P. Morgan Securities Inc. (J.P. Morgan) exempting Mandatory Enhanced Dividend Securities trusts for which J.P. Morgan will serve as a principal underwriter (Trusts) from Sections 12(d)(1) and 14(a) of the Investment Company Act, and exempting J.P. Morgan and the Trusts from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order permits other registered investment companies, and companies excepted from the definition of investment company under Sections 3(c)(1) and (c)(7) of the Act, to own a greater percentage of the total outstanding voting stock (Securities) of the Trusts than that permitted by Section 12(d)(1) of the Act. The order also exempts the Trusts from the initial net worth requirements of Section 14(a) of the Act and permits the Trusts to purchase U.S. Government securities from J.P. Morgan at the time of a Trust's initial issuance of Securities. (Rel. IC-24112 - October 26)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BANGOR HYDRO-ELECTRIC COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing Bangor Hydro-Electric Company (Bangor Hydro-Electric), a public utility holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(2) of the Act by Rule 2, and its wholly owned nonutility subsidiary, Penobscot Natural Gas Company (Penobscot Gas) (collectively, Applicants) to acquire through Penobscot Gas a 50% membership interest in Bangor Gas Company, LLC, a Maine limited liability company formed in 1997 to construct and operate a gas distribution system in the greater Bangor, Maine area. In addition, Applicants have been granted exemptions under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act exempting Bangor Hydro-Electric, Penobscot Gas and each of their subsidiary companies from all provisions of the Act, except Section 9(a)(2). SEMPRA ENERGY

An order has been issued authorizing Sempra Energy (Sempra), a public utility holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act, and its wholly owned subsidiary, Bangor Pacific, Inc. (Bangor Pacific), (collectively, Applicants), to acquire through Bangor Pacific 50% of the membership interests of Bangor Gas Company, LLC (Bangor Gas), a Maine limited liability company formed in 1997 to construct and operate a gas distribution system in the greater Bangor, Maine area. In addition, Applicants have been granted an exemption under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act exempting Sempra, Bangor Pacific and each of their subsidiary companies from all provisions of the Act, except Section 9(a)(2). SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Pacific Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PCX-99-35) to increase the percentage of options issues that may be allocated to a Lead Market Maker from 10% to 15% of the issues traded on the PCX. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 1. (Rel. 34-42051)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-CHX-99-22) and Amendment Nos. 1, 2 and 3 filed by the Chicago Stock Exchange relating to listing standards for trust issued receipts. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 1. (Rel. 34-42056)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change and Amendment No. 1 to the proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers delaying implementation of 90-second trade reporting as part of a pilot program extending the availability of certain Nasdaq services and facilities until 6:30 p.m. Eastern Time (SR-NASD-99-64) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 1. (Rel. 34-42057)

A proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-99-43) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange to assess a monthly fee to each seat owner for capital funding purposes has become immediately effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 1. (Rel. 34-42058)
