FEE RATE ADVISORY

The continuing resolution has been extended through Friday, November 5, 1999. Therefore, the fee rate on filings made pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Securities Act of 1933 will remain at the current rate of \$278 per \$1,000,000. Please note that when an appropriations bill is enacted, the fee rate will decrease to \$264 per \$1,000,000.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IN THE MATTER OF COUNTY OF NEVADA, ET AL.

An administrative law judge found that Virginia Horler, a senior vice president with Dain Rauscher, Inc. in 1990, violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities statutes in connection with a \$9.07 million municipal bond offering by Nevada County, California. Ms. Horler was the County's financial advisor on the offering, and she agreed to draft the official statement even though the underwriter had agreed to do the due diligence and to prepare the official statement.

Administrative Law Judge Brenda P. Murray found that Ms. Horler caused the official statement to contain material misrepresentations and to omit material information about the finances of the real estate development project, legal title to the land, and the developer's background and financial resources. The judge found Ms. Horler acted with scienter and she rejected Ms. Horler's arguments that (i) she did not have a legal duty that could give rise to liability as a primary violator; (ii) there were no omissions or misrepresentations for which she was liable; and (iii) she did not act with scienter and her actions were entirely appropriate under the circumstances. Judge Murray also rejected Ms. Horler's defense that her actions were appropriate because they mirrored the industry standard.

The judge did not order Ms. Horler to cease and desist from committing or causing violations of the antifraud provisions. Judge Murray concluded that a cease and desist order was not appropriate based on Ms. Horler's representation that she would not repeat the conduct that was the subject of this proceeding; her distinguished career as a securities professional and her lack of a disciplinary record; her willingness to accept the 1996 California guidelines which recommend a higher level of disclosure than she observed in 1990; and the fact that the violations occurred nine years ago in a single offering. FRAUD CHARGES FILED AGAINST SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA INDIVIDUALS AND NEVADA COMPANIES

The Commission has charged Ronald Mulhall and Eugene Carriere, Southern California residents, and Yes Entertainment, LLC, Yes Entertainment Network, LLC, and Yes Entertainment Network, Inc., Nevada-based entities (Defendants), with fraud in the sale of unregistered securities of Yes Entertainment, LLC, which operates Internet website-based "channels" offering family-oriented programming.

Defendants have raised \$8.8 million selling securities in Yes Entertainment, LLC to investors nationwide through boiler rooms in Los Angeles and elsewhere. Defendants tell investors that sales commissions are 12% when they are 45%, and that Mulhall is a "highly successful lawyer" when he was disbarred by the California State Bar for misappropriating client monies. Also, Defendants have diverted monies for personal use and have wired \$3.2 million to Hong Kong.

The lawsuit, filed in the United States District Court for the Central District of California, charges Defendants with violating Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

The Commission obtained an order temporarily enjoining Defendants from future violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws and freezing Defendants' assets. The Commission also seeks preliminary and permanent injunctions, disgorgement and civil penalties. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

T. ROWE PRICE ASSOCIATES, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by T. Rowe Price Associates, Inc., et al. for an order granting an exemption from Sections 12(d)(1), 17(a)(1), 17(a)(3), 18(f), and 21(b) of the Investment Company Act, and under Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 under the Act to permit certain joint arrangements. The order would supersede an existing order that permits certain registered investment companies to participate in a joint lending and borrowing facility. (Rel. IC-24116 - October 29)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALABAMA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Alabama Power Company (APC), a wholly owned electric public utility subsidiary of The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to allow APC to purchase and sell distribution facilities in accordance with a statute enacted by the state of Alabama. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>National</u> <u>Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-99-08) relating to the code of arbitration procedures for claims of employment discrimination. (Rel. 34-42061)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-Amex-99-44) filed by the <u>American Stock</u> <u>Exchange</u> has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The rule change: (1) amended the Amex Equity Fee Schedule for certain orders entered electronically into the Amex Order File from off the floor (System Orders); (2) eliminated specialist commissions on certain System Orders; and (3) implemented a program of revenue sharing with Exchange specialists. Publication of the notice in the <u>Federal Register</u> is expected during the week of November 1. (Rel. 34-42067)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change has been filed by the <u>Pacific Exchange</u> (SR-PCX-99-40) relating to Order Book Officials. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 1. (Rel. 34-42068)
