ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS AGAINST TERRANCE YOSHIKAWA AND KO SECURITIES, INC. REMANDED

The Commission has remanded to the NASD disciplinary proceedings against Ko Securities, Inc., an NASD member, and its president Terrance Yoshikawa. On December 11, 1997, the Commission sustained NASD disciplinary action against Ko and Yoshikawa based on their actions in effecting a series of five groups of transactions in the stock of DDI Pharmaceuticals, Inc. The Commission found that these trades constituted what is commonly known as "parking" and violated the NASD's rule requiring compliance with just and equitable principles of trade. On August 20, 1999, the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit reversed the Commission's findings of violation regarding four of the five sets of transactions, and remanded for further consideration with respect to the remaining set of transactions. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

STEPHENS GROUP, INC., ET AL.

Stephens Group, Inc., Stephens Inc., and Jackson T. Stephens have been granted a permanent conditional order from Section 9(a) of the Investment Company Act with respect to a securities-related injunction entered in 1978. (Rel. IC-24119 - November 2)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RILLE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> (SR-BSE-99-11) implementing a Post Primary Session. Publication of the order in the <u>Federal Register</u> is expected during the week of November 1. (Rel. 34-42074)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change and granted accelerated approval to Amendment No. 2 to the proposed rule change submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> relating to the National Adjudicatory Council's call for review of membership decisions. Publication of the order in the <u>Federal Register</u> is expected during the week of November 8. (Rel. 34-42091)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-99-43) filed by the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> to extend through January 3, 2000, the existing Pilot Fee Structure governing the reimbursement of NYSE member organizations for costs incurred in the transmission of proxy and other shareholder communication materials to shareholders owning securities in street name has become immediately effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 8. (Rel. 34-42086)

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> amending its membership dues and fees schedule for transactions occurring during the E-Session through December 31, 1999 (SR-CHX-99-23) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 8. (Rel. 34-42089)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to an amendment to a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-99-29) filed by the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> extending a pilot program relating to continued listing standards through December 1, 1999. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 8. (Rel. 34-42087)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-99-8) relating to reports of sales and purchases, pursuant to Rule G-14. Publication of the notice in the <u>Federal Register</u> is expected during the week of November 8. (Rel. 34-42090)
