#### COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### COMMISSION ISSUES RULE PROPOSAL TO ADDRESS APPLICATION OF THE INVESTMENT ADVISERS ACT TO NEW BROKERAGE PROGRAMS

The Commission this week proposed a new rule that would address the application of the Investment Advisers Act to broker-dealers that charge fees based on the amount of assets in customers' accounts, instead of commissions and mark-ups. The proposal will be issued for a 60-day public comment period prior to being considered for final adoption by the Commission.

SEC Chairman Arthur Levitt said, "This proposal represents a sensible way to allow full service brokerage firms to offer pricing choices to their customers without imposing unnecessary regulatory obstacles or sacrificing investor protection. Asset-based fee programs better align the interests of customers and their brokers. The proposed rule would assure, however, that when an account bears the fundamental characteristics of an advisory account, it will be subject to the Advisers Act."

Currently, due to the form of compensation they receive, brokers that charge their customers asset-based fees may be subject to regulation under the Advisers Act, as well as the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposed rule makes the nature of the services provided, rather than the form of compensation, the primary factor in determining whether the Advisers Act applies. Under the proposed rule, if the broker does not have discretionary authority to trade securities in an account, the Advisers Act generally would not apply to that account. If the broker does have discretionary authority and charges an asset-based fee, the account would be subject to the Advisers Act.

The new asset-based pricing of brokerage services is responsive to the "best practices" identified in 1995 by the Committee on Compensation Practices. That Committee, formed at the request of Chairman Levitt to identify the brokerage industry's "best practices," recommended that brokers shift at least a portion of their fees to asset-based compensation in order to better align the interests of the brokers, their registered representatives, and their clients.

### HOUSEHOLDING RULE AMENDMENTS

The Commission has issued a release adopting rule changes to permit the delivery of a single copy of a prospectus or shareholder report to investors who share the same address. New Rule 154 under the Securities Act of 1933 will permit the delivery of a single prospectus, and amendments to Rules 30d-1 and 30d-2 under the Investment Company Act and to Rules 14a-3, 14c-3, and 14c-7 under the Securities Exchange Act will permit delivery of one shareholder report. The Commission also has issued a release proposing proxy rule changes that would permit delivery of a single proxy or information statement to investors sharing the same address. ### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

## COMMISSION SETTLES PUBLIC ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AGAINST MICHAEL REHTORIK

On November 4, the Commission instituted and simultaneously settled public administrative proceedings, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), against Michael W. Rehtorik (Rehtorik). In the Order, the Commission barred Rehtorik from participating in any offering of penny stock. The Order finds that on October 22, 1999, the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee permanently enjoined Rehtorik, by consent, from further violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 The permanent injunction followed a civil action thereunder. initiated by a complaint filed by the Commission on September 23, 1998, alleging that Rehtorik, the Managing Director and Director of Strategies and Investor Relations for Genesis International Financial Services, Inc. (Genesis) promoted the stock of Genesis through fraudulent Commission filings and company press releases.

The complaint further alleges that once the price of the stock had been inflated artificially through his efforts, Rehtorik and others sold Genesis stock through nominee accounts, then booked a portion of the proceeds as income to Genesis. (Rel. 34-42097; File No. 3-10090)

### ORDER PERMITTING ASSOCIATION OF CHARLES ZARZECKI

On November 4, the Commission issued an Order approving the application of the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (NASD) for relief from a statutory disqualification to permit the association of Charles M. Zarzecki as a General Securities Trader Representative and Equity with Research Conversion Corporation, a member of the NASD. The Order states that, based on the representations made regarding the supervision of Mr. Zarzecki, and the terms and conditions of his association, the Commission will not institute proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) or 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and will not direct the NASD to bar the proposed association pursuant to Section 15A(g)(2). The Order is necessary because Mr. Zarzecki is subject to a 1993 order of the Commission barring him from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, municipal securities dealer, or registered investment adviser. ## SETTLEMENT OFFERS OF ANDREW BRESSMAN, ROMAN OKIN AND RICHARD SIMONE ACCEPTED

On November 4, the Commission, by consent, entered separate Orders Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions and Cease and Desist Orders as to Andrew Bressman, Roman Okin and Richard Simone, all former registered representatives of the defunct broker-dealer A.R. Baron & Co., Inc. These Orders settle as to these respondents the administrative proceedings instituted on May 23, 1996 (Adm. Proc. 3-9010) against A.R. Baron & Co., Inc., Andrew Bressman and Roman Okin, and on October 17, 1996 (Adm. Proc. 3-9168) against A.R. Baron & Co. Inc., Andrew Bressman, Roman Okin, Richard Acosta, Richard Simone, Burton Blank, Mark Goldman and Jack Wolynez pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and Sections 15(b)(6), 19(h) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act). On October 17, 1996, A.R. Baron & Co., Inc. was dismissed from these proceedings pursuant to an Offer of Settlement accepted by the Commission. On December 6, 1996, the Commission postponed these proceedings at the request of the District Attorney for New York County. Since that time, respondents Andrew Bressman, Roman Okin, Richard Acosta, Richard Simone, Mark Goldman and Jack Wolynez have been indicted and criminally convicted in connection with their activities at A.R. Baron & Co., Inc.

The Orders as to Andrew Bressman and Roman Okin state that Bressman and Okin engaged in stock manipulation and repeated abusive sales practices. The Order as to Richard Simone states that Simone placed unauthorized stock purchases in a customer's accounts.

The Orders as to Bressman and Okin find that Bressman and Okin each willfully violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and Sections 9(a)(2), 9(a)(4) and 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and that each willfully aided, abetted and caused violations of Sections 7(c) and 15(c)(1) of the Exchange Act and Rule 15c1-2 thereunder and Regulation T promulgated by the Federal Reserve Board. The Order as to Simone finds that Simone willfully violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

Bressman and Okin were each ordered to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation and any future violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Sections 7(c), 9(a)(2), 9(a)(4), 10(b) and 15(c)(1) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 15c-2 thereunder and Regulation T promulgated by the Federal Reserve Board. Simone was ordered to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation and any future violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. All three respondents were ordered barred from association with any broker or dealer. In addition, Bressman and Okin were each ordered to disgorge \$6,038, 412 and \$622,584, respectively, to be paid in installments from their future earnings. ## FORMER PRINCIPALS AND BRANCH OWNER OF NEW JERSEY BROKER-DEALER BARRED FROM ASSOCIATING WITH A BROKER-DEALER AND FROM PARTICIPATING IN AN OFFERING OF PENNY STOCK

The Commission announced that on November 4 it issued an Order instituting and settling public administrative proceedings against Lawrence J. Penna and Herman Epstein, former principals of Investors Associates, Inc., a now-defunct New Jersey broker-dealer, and against Douglas J. Mangan, former co-owner of the Melville, New York office of Investors Associates. The Order bars Penna, Epstein and Mangan from being associated with a broker or dealer and from participating in an offering of penny stock, pursuant to Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The Commission's Order is based on final judgments of permanent injunction entered against Penna, Epstein and Mangan on September 13, 1999, as the result of a civil action filed by the Commission. SEC v. Lawrence J. Penna, Herman Epstein and Douglas J. Mangan, 99 Civ. 9406 (U.S. District Court, S.D.N.Y. September 2, 1999) (Litigation Release No. 16270). In that case, the Commission alleged that Penna, Epstein and Mangan participated in fraudulent public offerings of securities for five separate companies (Interiors, Inc., Compare Generiks, Inc., Perry's Majestic Beer, Inc., Decor Group, Inc. and Superior Supplements, Inc.) between September 1995 and February 1997 and in the subsequent manipulation of the market in those securities.

In a parallel criminal proceeding, the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York filed criminal informations on September 2, 1999, charging Penna and Epstein with perjury before the Commission's staff during its investigation and charging Penna, Epstein and Mangan with multiple counts of securities fraud in connection with the five fraudulent offerings, as well as other crimes. Epstein and Mangan pled guilty on September 14, 1999, and Penna entered his guilty plea on October 5, 1999. (Rel. 34-42106; File No. 3-10091)

## PUBLIC ADMINISTRATIVE AND CEASE AND DESIST PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST INDIVIDUAL FOR SELLING UNREGISTERED SECURITIES AND ACTING AS A BROKER WITHOUT REGISTRATION

On November 4, the Commission instituted public administrative and cease and desist proceedings, pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and Sections 15(b)(6), 19(h) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), against Respondent Jerry C. Berman for willfully violating, and committing or causing violations of, Section 5 of the Securities Act and Section 15(a)(1) of the Exchange Act.

The Division of Enforcement alleged that Respondent, as a consultant to Stratcomm Media Ltd. (Stratcomm) and Corporate Relations Group, Inc. (CRG) its wholly-owned subsidiary, sold more than 310,000 shares of Stratcomm common stock in violation of the registration provision of the federal securities laws, earning commissions from Stratcomm and CRG of over \$50,000. Stratcomm had not filed a registration statement concerning these common stock sales, nor was there a registration statement in effect or an exemption from registration available to Stratcomm. Moreover, Respondent was not registered as a broker. (Rel. 33-7768; 34-42107; File No. 3-10092)

### REGISTRATION OF THE STOCK OF DYNAMIC AMERICAN CORPORATION IS REVOKED

On November 1, the registration of the stock of Dynamic American Corporation was revoked under the Securities Exchange Act. Dynamic American, now a defunct Utah shell corporation, formerly had an office in Salt Lake City, Utah. The proceedings alleged that Dynamic American failed to file required Form 10-K annual reports or Form 10-Q quarterly reports for any period after the quarter ended September 30, 1995. Section 12(j) of the Exchange Act provides that if the registration of a security is revoked, no broker-dealer can use interstate commerce to effect any transactions in the stock. Dynamic American failed to answer the Order or to otherwise defend the proceeding.

In a related proceeding filed in August 1999, the Commission alleged that Robert G. Weeks, David A. Hesterman, and J. Edwards Cox of Salt Lake City, Kenneth L. Weeks of Draper, Utah, Jethro J. Barlow, CPA of Hilldale, Utah, and Alan K. Burton of Novato, California, defrauded investors in Dynamic American by failing to disclose the identities of the company's true control persons, grossly overvaluing the company's Bolivian and U.S. mineral assets, and accumulating nearly \$4 million through a massive, unregistered

distribution of its stock.

R. Weeks and Hesterman were indicted last year by a federal grand jury in connection with their activities at another publicly traded mining company (U.S. v. Robert G. Weeks et al., No. 2:98CR 0278S, D. Utah, May 27, 1998). (Rel. 34-42081; File No. 3-9951)

The Commission has extended a temporary order exempting Bankers Trust Company (BT) and entities of which BT is or becomes an affiliated person from Section 9(a) of the Investment Company Act until the Commission takes final action on an application for a permanent order or, if earlier, March 8, 2000.
