PAPER COPY DISSEMINATION OF SEC NEWS DIGEST TO BE DISCONTINUED

By the end of March, the Office of Public Affairs will complete its transition to electronic publication of the SEC News Digest. As a result, after March 29, 1996 paper copies of the Digest will no longer be mailed or made available at Headquarters for messenger pick-up. Instead, we will be publishing the Digest on the Commission's World Wide Web site and the FedWorld electronic bulletin board. It will also enable us to devote more of our resources to expanding and improving the scope of our electronic information C_SECTINATION services. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

PUBLIC ADMINISTRATIVE AND CEASE AND DESIST PROCEEDINGS AGAINST RICHARD WIWI AND ORACLE PARTNERS SETTLED

The Commission announced that it settled public administrative and cease and desist proceedings against Richard G. Wiwi (Wiwi) and Oracle Partners (Oracle) (collectively, Respondents), previously instituted on September 19, 1995. The Commission accepted the Respondents' offer in which they consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, to the entry of a cease and desist order and to the entry of an order requiring Wiwi to pay civil penalties in the amount of \$12,500 and suspending Wiwi from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company for a period of eight months.

The Order Making Findings and Imposing Sanctions finds that Wiwi and Oracle engaged in an unregistered offer and sale of the securities of Oracle to the general public, Oracle failed to register as an investment company and Wiwi willfully aided and abetted and caused Oracle's violation. In addition, the Order finds that Wiwi and Oracle made misrepresentations and omissions to investors regarding, among other things, the length of time Oracle had been in existence and Oracle's investment history. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell short-term and termloan notes and/or commercial paper from time to time prior to April 1, 2001, in an aggregate amount at any time outstanding not to exceed \$2 billion. The proceeds of the borrowings and sales of commercial paper would be used by Southern to invest in subsidiaries and to make additional investments in exempt wholesale generators and foreign utility companies, subject to certain limitations. (Rel. 35-26489)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Georgia Power Company (Georgia), an electric utility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered public-utility holding company, whereby Georgia will issue and sell from time to time, prior to January 1, 2003, short-term and/or term-loan notes to lenders and/or commercial paper to or through dealers in an aggregate principal amount at any one time outstanding of up to \$1.7 billion. (Rel. 35-26490)

MISSISSIPPI POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Mississippi Power Company (Mississippi), an electric utility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered public-utility holding company, whereby Mississippi will issue and sell from time to time, prior to January 1, 2003, short-term and/or term-loan notes to lenders and/or commercial paper to or through dealers in an aggregate principal amount at any one time outstanding of up to \$350 million. (Rel. 35-26491)

SAVANNAH ELECTRIC AND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Savannah Electric and Power Company (Savannah), an electric utility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered public-utility holding company, whereby Savannah will issue and sell from time to time, prior to January 1, 2003, short-term and/or term-loan notes to lenders and/or commercial paper to or through dealers in an uggregate principal amount at any one time outstanding of up to \$90 million. (Rel. 35-26492)

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES

An order has been issued authorizing Eastern Utilities Associates (EUA), a registered holding company, to acquire a new subsidiary that has a 30% ownership interest in Duke/Louis Dreyfus (New England) LLC (LLC), a company engaged in the business of marketing and brokering power in wholesale markets, marketing fuel on a limited basis and providing various other energy-related services. Authorization was also granted for various financing and credit support transactions among EUA, EUA Energy Services, Inc., and LLC through December 31, 2000, and for LLC and certain nonutility companies in the EUA system to provide services to one another at market prices. Jurisdiction was reserved over LLC's selling and brokering fuel to any party other than an electric power producer, over retail sales of electricity and fuels by LLC, and over an exception from the "at cost" rules for provision of goods and services between LLC and EUA's service or utility subsidiaries.
