COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC ENGAGES ARTHUR WYATT AS INTERNATIONAL ACCOUNTING EXPERT

Chairman Levitt is pleased to announce that the Commission has engaged Arthur R. Wyatt, Ph.D, CPA, as an expert consultant in the Office of the Chief Accountant. In this new role, Professor Wyatt will act as senior policy adviser to Chief Accountant Michael H. Sutton for the Commission's initiatives involving the development of international accounting standards. In particular, Professor Wyatt will play a key role in monitoring the development of international accounting standards by the International Accounting Standards Committee (IASC). (Press Rel. 96-71)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

RULE 102(e) PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST STEVEN HIRATSUKA, CPA AND SUSAN SOLTIS, CPA

The Commission instituted proceedings pursuant to Rule 102(e) against Steven T. Hiratsuka and M. Susan Soltis, both CPAs practicing in the Denver, Colorado area. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Hiratsuka's and Soltis' offers of settlement in which they each consent to the entry of an order, without admitting or denying the findings contained in the order, that denies them the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission as an accountant with the right to reapply after twelve months.

The order for proceedings finds that Hiratsuka and Soltis engaged in improper professional conduct during their audit of the financial statements of KLH Engineering Group, Inc. (UKLHU) filed in its Form 10-KSB for 1992. Hiratsuka and Soltis were partner-in-charge and audit manager, respectively, of the Lehman Butterwick & Company audit of KLII's 1992 annual financial statements. The order also finds that these financial statements were materially false and misleading in that they, among other things, overstated assets and stockholders' equity. Hiratsuka and Soltis failed to obtain sufficient competent evidential matter to support management's representation that the acquisition of two corporations by KLH in exchange for its newly-issued stock had a value of \$1,926,000.

The order further finds that Hiratsuka and Soltis failed to perform the audit in conformity with Generally Accepted Audit ng Standards and failed to determine that KLH's financial statements were not prepared in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONNECTICUT GENERAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 3 to request a hearing on an application filed by Connecticut General Life Insurance Company (CG Life), CG Variable Annuity Separate Account II (Variable Account), and Cigna Financial Advisors, Inc. The application requests an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from: (i) the assets of the Variable Account, in connection with the offer and sale of certain flexible premium deferred annuity contracts (Contracts) and any contracts (Future Contracts) offered in the future by CG Life which are substantially similar in all material respects to the Contracts; and (ii) the assets of any separate account established in the future by CG Life, in connection with the offer and sale of Future Contracts. Applicants propose that the order extend to any broker-dealer which may serve in the future as principal underwriter with respect to the Contracts or Future Contracts, and which is or will be registered with the Commission as a broker-dealer under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and a member of the National Association of Securities Dealers. DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>New York</u> <u>Stock Exchange</u> to strike from listing and registration Maybelline, Inc., Common Stock, \$.01 Par Value. (Rel. 34-37192)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPUSED RULES

The Commission has approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> (SR-CBOE-96-25) that makes certain changes to its rules relating to the requirement to make prior arrangements to borrow stock or to obtain other assurances that delivery can be made on settlement date before a member or person associated with a member may sell short. Publication of the Order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 13. (Rel. 34-37187)

The Commission has approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-96-08), as amended, by the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> that permits the listing and trading of Commodity Indexed Preferred Securities (Securities). The value of the Securities will be linked to changes in a single commodity. Publication of the Order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 13. (Rel. 34-37188)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission is approving a proposed rule change filed by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-96-11). The rule change amends Article III, Section 49 of the NASD Rules of Fair Practice, the Primary Market Maker (PMM) Standards rule, by deleting a provision of the rule that allows a market maker to become a PMM in an issue by registering in the stock and refraining from quoting the issue for five days. ORDER APPROVING FILING OF PROPOSED RESTATEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS TO THE RESTATED CONSOLIDATED TAPE ASSOCIATION PLAN AND THE CONSOLIDATED QUOTATION PLAN

On May 9, the Commission approved amendments to the Restated Consolidated Tape Association Plan and the Consolidated Quotation Plan (SR-CTA/CQ-96-1). Publication of the Order in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u> is expected during the week of May 13. (Rel. 34-37191)
