ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

PUBLIC PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST JOHN SILSETH

The Commission announced the issuance of an order instituting administrative and cease-and-desist proceedings pursuant to Sections 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and Sections 15(b), 19(h) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against John Silseth (Silseth). The order alleges that Silseth aided and abetted his customers' market manipulation of Angeion Corporation's (Angeion) common stock. specifically alleges that between March 1991 and June 1991, Silseth caused and willfully aided and abetted violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder in that he knew or was reckless in not knowing that four customer accounts engaged in matched trades and that one customer account engaged in wash trades. Silseth provided knowing and substantial assistance with respect to the customers' violations by acting as the registered representative for these accounts and executing five matched trades involving 178,000 shares of Angeion valued at approximately \$1.4 million and at least two wash trades involving 125,000 shares of Angeion valued at approximately \$1.1 million.

A public hearing will be held to determine whether the allegations against Silseth are true, to offer him an opportunity to establish any defenses to such allegations and to determine what remedial action, if any, is appropriate. (Rel. 33-7291; 34-37206)

PUBLIC PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST DAVID ANDERSON

The Commission announced the issuance of an order instituting administrative and cease-and-desist proceedings pursuant to Sections 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and Sections 15(b), 19(h) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against David Anderson (Anderson). The order alleges

that Anderson aided and abetted his customers' market manipulation of Angeion Corporation's (Angeion) common stock. The order specifically alleges that between December 1990 and May 1991, Anderson caused and willfully aided and abetted violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder in that he knew or was reckless in not knowing that three customer accounts engaged in matched trades and that one customer account engaged in wash trades. Anderson provided knowing and substantial assistance with respect to the customers' violations by acting as the registered representative for these accounts and executing three matched trades involving 95,000 shares of Angeion valued at approximately \$820,000 and at least two wash trades involving 110,000 shares of Angeion valued at approximately \$963,000.

A public hearing will be held to determine whether the allegations against Anderson are true, to offer him an opportunity to establish any defenses to such allegations and to determine what remedial action, if any, is appropriate. (Rel. 33-7292; 34-37207)

DISTRICT COURT APPROVES WITHDRAWAL OF CLAIMS BY ERIC ROSENFELD AND WITHDRAWAL OF FUND ADMINISTRATOR'S DETERMINATION

On May 10, the Honorable Robert P. Patterson, Jr., U.S. District Court Judge for the Southern District of New York, issued an order approving the withdrawal with prejudice of all claims made on behalf of Eric Rosenfeld to participate in the settlement fund established in <u>In re Salomon Inc Securities Litigation</u>, 91 Civ. 5442 (S.D.N.Y.) (RPP). The order also approved the withdrawal of the determinations of Joel L. Carr, the Fund Administrator, reflected in his Memorandum to the Court dated April 11, 1996. [SEC v. Salomon Inc and Salomon Brothers Inc, 92 Civ. 3691, SDNY, RPP] (LR-14911)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SAFECO LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, et al.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 7 to request a hearing on an application filed by SAFECO Life Insurance Company (SAFECO), SAFECO Separate Account C, SAFECO Securities, Inc. (SSI), Princor Financial Services Corporation, and Principal Marketing Services, Inc. (Principal Marketing). Applicants seek an order pursuant to Section 11(a) of the Investment Company Act approving the terms of an offer to exchange interests in certain variable annuity contracts issued by Principal Mutual Life Insurance Company for variable annuity contracts issued by SAFECO. (Rel. IC-21953 - May 13)

THE WOODWARD FUNDS, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by The Woodward Funds, et al. under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act, permitting certain series of the Woodward Funds to acquire all of the assets of certain series of the Prairie Institutional Funds in exchange for shares of The Woodward Funds. Because of certain affiliations, the series involved may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel. IC-21954 - May 13)

GLICKENHAUS & CO., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Glickenhaus & Co., et al. under Sections 11(a) and 11(c) of the Investment Company Act permitting certain offers of exchange between unit investment trusts. (Rel. IC-21955 - May 14)

BLUE CHIP VALUE FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 10 to request a hearing on an application filed by Blue Chip Value Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act that would grant an exemption from Section 19(b) of the Act and Rule 19b-1 thereunder. The order would permit applicant to make up to four distributions of long-term capital gains in any one taxable year, so long as applicant maintains in effect a distribution policy calling for quarterly distributions of a fixed percentage of its net asset value. (Rel. IC-21956 - May 14)

EMERGING MARKETS GROWTH FUND, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 12(d)(1) of the Act, under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act, and pursuant to Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder. The order permits Emerging Markets Growth Fund, Inc. to invest up to 1% of its total assets in an affiliated closed-end Singapore investment company that invests in securities of companies in East and Southeast Asia. (Rel. IC-21957; IS-979 - May 14)

An order has been issued granting the application of CII Financial, Inc. to withdraw from listing and registration on its 7 1/2% Convertible Subordinated Debentures, due 2001 on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-37213)

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 5 to comment on the application of Star Multi Care Services, Inc. to withdraw from listing and registration on the <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> its Common Stock, \$0.001 Par Value. (Rel. 34-37216)

TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission temporarily approved a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-95-17) filed by the <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> under Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act through May 31, 1997. The rule change establishes additional procedures for placing settling members on Class A Surveillance and for collecting clearing fund and other collateral deposits from settling members. (Rel. 34-37202)

AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed an amendment to a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-95-20) filed under Section 19(b) of the Securities Exchange Act relating to the issuance, clearance, and settlement of Buy-Write Options Unitary Derivatives. Publication of the amendment is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 13. (Rel. 34-37203)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by <u>MBS Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-MBSCC-95-08) relating to eligibility changes for settlement balance order settlement. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 20. (Rel. 34-37205)

The Commission granted approval to a proposed rule change filed by The Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-95-27) under Section 19(b) of the Exchange Act implementing the initial public offering Tracking System. (Rel. 34-37208)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE
