ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST WENDELL LEE

The Commission has instituted public administrative proceedings against Wendell Jeffrey Lee (Lee) pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Exchange Act.

The Commission's Order Instituting Public Proceedings (Order) alleges that Lee, who was employed as a registered representative in the Jenkintown, Pennsylvania branch office of W.H. Newbold's Son & Co. (Newbold's), a division of Fahnestock & Co., Inc., a brokerdealer registered with the Commission, violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder by misappropriating the proceeds of unauthorized securities transactions. Specifically, the Order alleges that from April 1993 through May 1994, Lee engaged in a scheme to defraud at least two Newbold's brokerage customers of approximately \$262,000 by liquidating securities in the customers' accounts, without their knowledge or consent, and misappropriating the proceeds of such transactions. Lee forged customers' signatures on numerous letters authorizing instructing Newbold's to issue checks drawn against the customers' accounts. He then misappropriated the checks and converted the Lee also caused Newbold's to make unauthorized wire proceeds. transfers of funds out of a customer account and into third-party accounts for his benefit.

The Order also alleges that, based on the above-described conduct, Lee pled guilty to sixteen counts of felony forgery (Commonwealth of Pennsylvania v. Wendell Jeffrey Lee, Docket Nos. 1319-95 and 1478-95, Court of Common Pleas, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania). The Order further alleges that an injunction was entered against Lee on January 4, 1996 enjoining him from future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. On September 27, 1995, the Commission filed a civil injunctive action against Lee (SEC v. Wendell Jeffrey Lee, 2:95-CV-06088; See also LR-14659). (Rel. 34-37247)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GPU GENERATION CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 17 to request a hearing on a proposal by GPU Generation Corporation (GENCO), a nonutility subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), a registered holding company, and GPU's electric utility subsidiary companies, Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L), Metropolitan Edison Company (Met-Ed), and Pennsylvania Electric Company (together with JCP&L and Met-Ed, Operating Companies), whereby GENCO will perform certain operation and maintenance services for nonutility generators previously performed and to be performed by the Operating Companies. PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 17 to request a hearing on a proposal by Public Service Company of Oklahoma, an electric public-utility subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to increase its investment in Excel Technologies, Ltd. to \$2,718,764.91, from \$2.35 million, and to consummate certain related purchases and exchanges of securities issued by Excel. COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 17 to request a hearing on a proposal by Columbia Gas System, Inc. (CGS), a registered holding company, and three of its wholly-owned non-utility subsidiaries, Columbia Energy Services Corporation (CES), Columbia Natural Resources, Inc. (CNR) and Columbia Coal Gasification Corporation (CGC). Applicants request authorization to reorganize their existing corporate structure by (1) reincorporating CES in Delaware via a merger into a newly-formed successor corporation for the sole purpose of converting CES from a Kentucky to a Delaware corporation and (2) merging CGC with and into CNR with CNR being the surviving corporation.
