ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST FORMER PARTNERS OF MOORE AND SCHLEY

The Commission has instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Robert Sayegh (Sayegh), Thomas Core (Core), and John J. Cranley (Cranley), former partners at Moore & Schley, Cameron & Co., a now defunct broker-dealer firm whose offices were located at 45 Broadway, New York, New York.

The Order Instituting Public Proceedings (Order) alleges that, between September 1987 and February 1989, Sayegh, the over-the-counter trader at Moore & Schley, Core, the branch manager of the 45 Broadway office and Cranley, the firm's managing partner, participated in a fraudulent scheme to manipulate the price of American Depositary Receipts of the Institute of Clinical Pharmacology, an Irish corporation. The Order further alleges that Cranley and Core, between August and December 1988, participated in a course of conduct to manipulate the stock of Chase Medical Group, Inc.

On November 1, 1994, Cranley and CORE were each enjoined, by consent, in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York from violations of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder (SEC v. Militano, JFK, SDNY).

On November 1, 1995, Judge John F. Keenan made findings, after a two week trial, that Sayegh violated Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder in connection with his conduct in manipulating the price of ICP ADRs between September 1987 and February 1989 and permanently enjoined Sayegh from future violations of these provisions.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine if the allegations against Cranley, Core and Sayegh are true and, if so, what remedial sanctions, if any, are appropriate against each of them in light of their conduct and the injunctions entered against them. (Rel. 34-37272)

PERMANENT INJUNCTION AGAINST MICHAEL FOUSSE

On February 22, the Honorable G. Ernest Tidwell, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Georgia, entered an order of permanent injunction, enjoining Michael J. Fousse (Fousse) from violating Section 5 and Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 15(a)(1) and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 thereunder.

The defendant consented to the relief without admitting or denying the allegations set forth in a complaint filed by the Commission on September 23, 1994. The Court further ordered Fousse to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$37,200, including pre-judgment interest but waived payment of the disgorgement and declined to impose civil penalties based upon sworn representations by Fousse concerning his inability to pay said amounts.

The Commission alleged that the defendants violated the registration, antifraud and broker-dealer registration requirements of the federal securities laws in the offering of common stock. Rand Instrument Corporation was purportedly in the business of developing and selling night vision equipment for military applications to the United States government and to foreign governments. Fousse was employed at Rand Instrument Corporation as assistant vice president of investment from October 1992 until the middle of 1993. [SEC v. Rand Instrument Corporation, Alan E. Rand, Cathleen M. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SIERRA ASSET MANAGEMENT TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Sierra Asset Management Trust (Trust), et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 12(d)(1) of the Act and under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act. The requested order would permit the Trust to operate as a "fund of funds." (Rel. IC-22001 - June 3)

MINORCO S.A.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Minorco S.A. under Section 3(b)(2) of the Investment Company Act declaring applicant to be primarily engaged in a business other than that of investing, reinvesting, owning, holding, or trading in securities. (Rel. IC-22002; IS-991 - June 4)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-96-33) filed by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> has become immediately effective. The proposed rule change adds Interpretation .06 to Rule 24.9, Terms of Index Option Contracts, concerning the addition of strike prices for options on the Mexican Indice de Precious y Cotizaciones. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 10. (Rel. 34-37257; IS-989)

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-96-26) filed by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> to set forth its interpretation of the meaning of an existing Exchange rule concerning the obligation of a floor broker to continuously represent certain orders at the trading station where the option class is traded, has become immediately effective. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal</u> Register during the week of June 10. (Rel. 34-37264)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u>, (SR-CHX-96-13) to modify the hours of its Primary Trading Session and to adopt a Post Primary Trading Session. (Rel. 34-37265)

AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION FROM REGISTRATION

The Commission granted the <u>Arizona Stock Exchange</u> (AZX) an amendment to its application for exemption from registration as an exchange to permit AZX to operate a single auction during regular trading hours; and to make technical corrections to the original exemption order to conform to changes in the operation of the system since the original order was issued and clarify reporting requirements applicable to AZX under the original order. (Rel. 34-37271)
